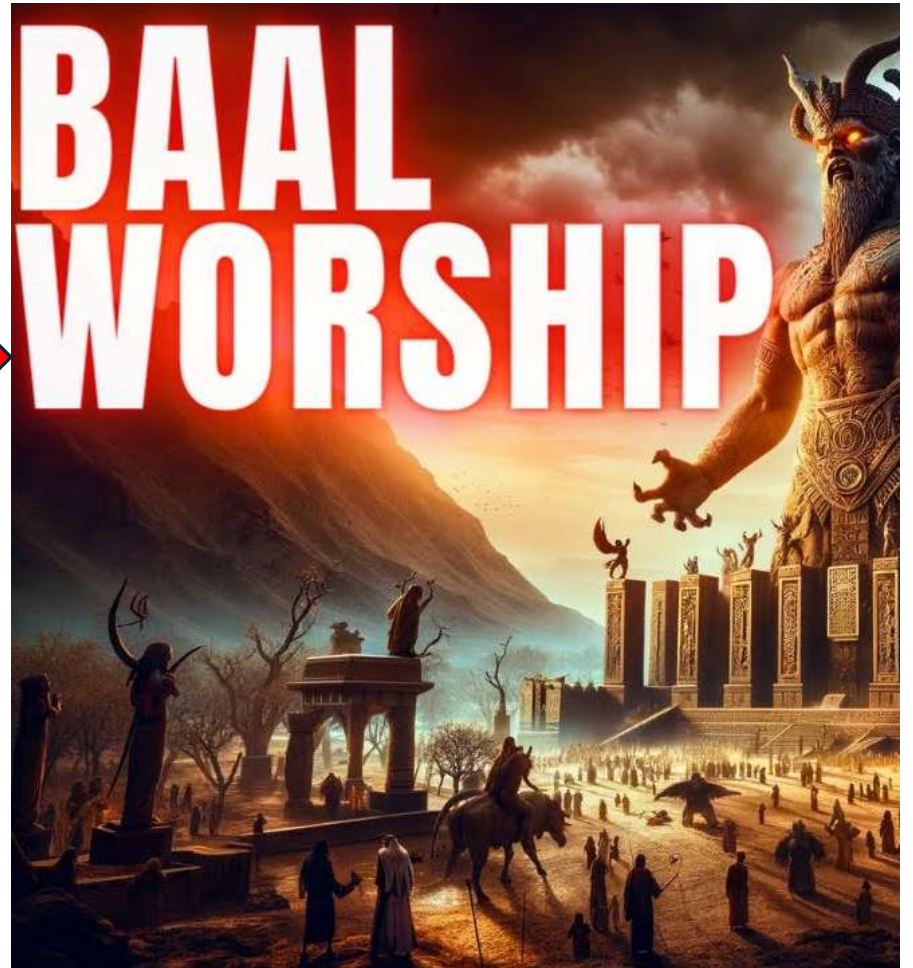


The Elimination of

Message #7

ELISHA



- This is our last message in the **Elisha** series
- In this message, we continue our study of the wicked king of Israel, King Joram, the son of Ahab and Jezebel, his death by the hand of Jehu, and the death of the associates of Ahab.
- **We will end the series with the death of Elisha.**
- As noted in our last message, this story about Jehu and his company is a picture of Jesus and the corporate church.
- I'm going to recap a bit of the last message as a precursor to this message and will be doing a parallel to the book of Revelations.



- In 2 Kings 9:16 Jehu rode in his chariot to Jezreel.
 - King Joram, son of Ahab and Jezebel had been wounded by the Syrians, and he had retreated to the palace at Jezreel.
 - The capital of the northern Kingdom was Israel, and the capital city was Samaria.
 - Jehu was a military commander anointed by the prophet Elisha to become king of Israel and to carry out divine judgment on the house of Ahab.
 - Jehu and his family spent most of their time in the northern kingdom.
 - But Ahab had another palace at Jezreel. It was a beautiful palace and that's where the king's court stay at times.
 - And so, Joram after he had been wounded in battle, went back to the palace at Jezreel to heal.

- Now Jehu is driving furiously to Jezreel because he is going to do what God told him to do – exterminate the house of Ahab.
 - Jehoram's watchman saw Jehu coming in the distance. He said in 2 Kings 9:17, "I see a company".
 - In verse 18, the watchman sends one out on horseback to meet Jehu about two or three miles outside the city.
 - Jehu told the watchmen to turn behind him, to join his forces, and he did.
 - The watchman sent a second messenger out who again switched allegiance and got behind Jehu.
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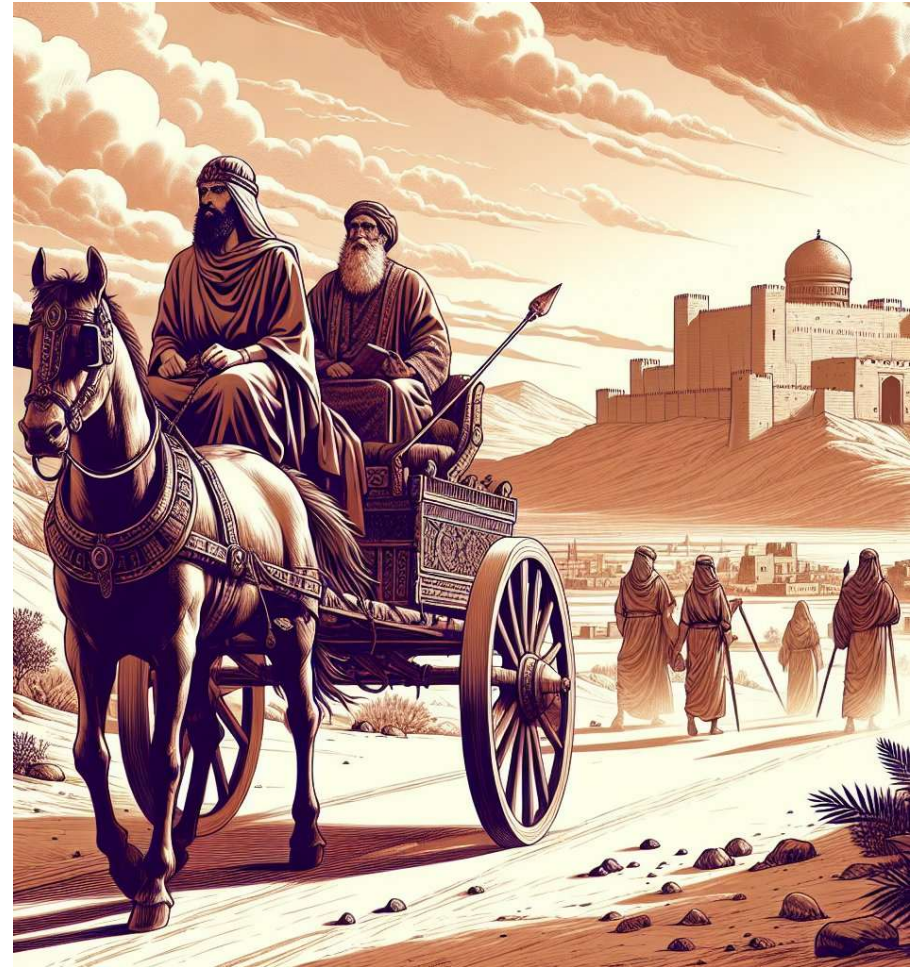
- Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:7
- Hebrews 7:16 says that the high priestly ministry of Jesus Christ is an endless life.
- This picture of the two messengers switching allegiance and following Jehu is a representation of the global harvest as men and women will be faced with a decision to stay behind a wicked king and be killed or get behind the true Christ.
- It is a representation of those coming from darkness to light, coming out of the old order into the new order; the countless number of people who will come out of the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of His dear son, the righteous King.



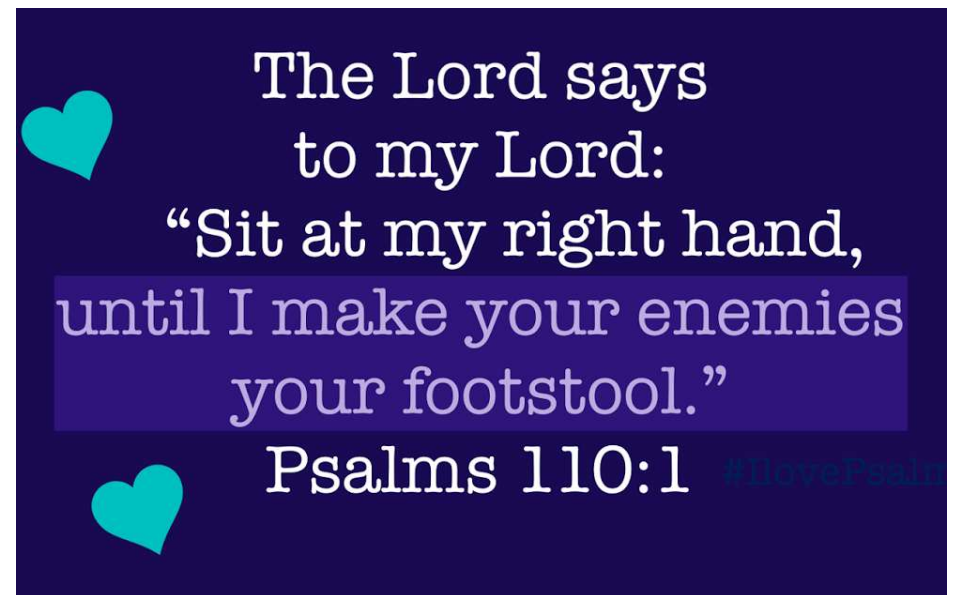
- Jehu driving furiously is a picture of Jesus coming with righteous judgment and all those who are riding with him.
- The watchmen knew it was Jehu coming by the way Jehu was driving like a madman with haste and great speed and he is coming with his company.
- This company is ever growing as there are those who will switch allegiance.
- This company is coming to stamp out the house of Ahab and eradicate BAAL worship from the land of Israel.



- Joram was still recovering from his wounds and was weak; yet in verse 21 he said, “Make ready” and his chariot was made ready.
- Ahaziah, King of Judah had come down to visit Joram.
- Ahaziah was Joram’s nephew, the grandson of Jezebel.
- So, the two, Ahaziah of Judah and Uncle Joram of Israel went out to meet Jehu.
- This wicked corrupt seed of Ahab and Jezebel had infiltrated both the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah.
- Both of their lives will be taken at the hand of Jehu.



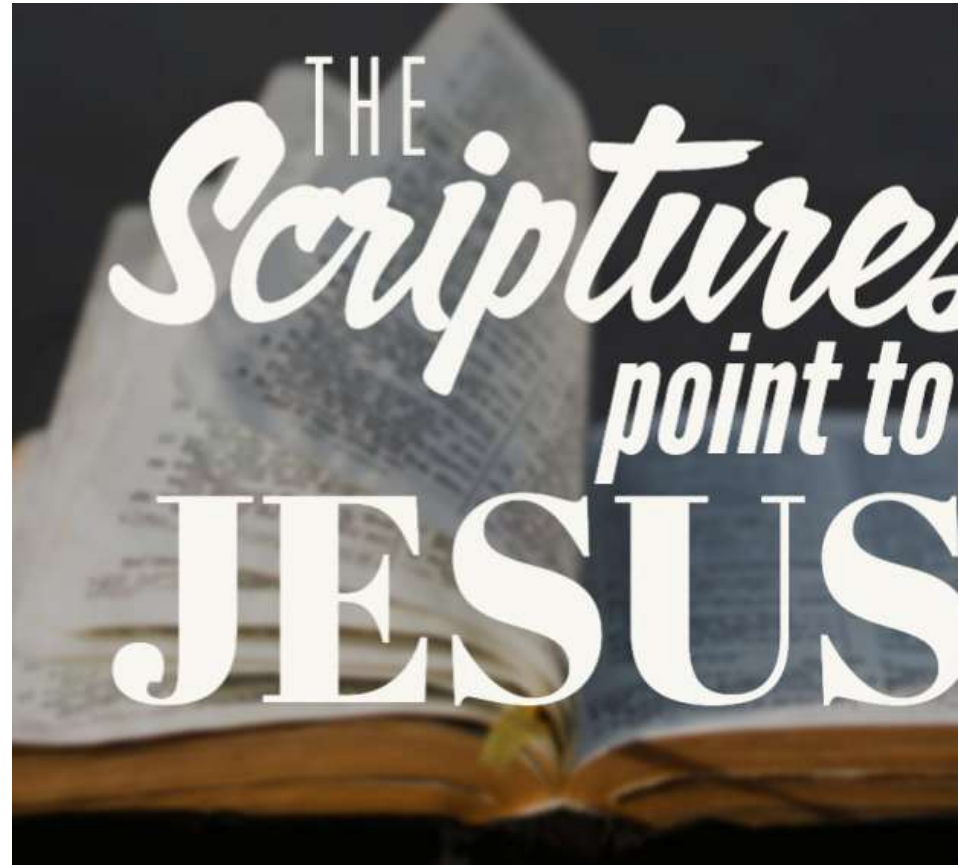
- Jehu had a commission from Elisha to eradicate the house of Ahab.
- It's a picture of Psalms 110:1.
 - The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- This scripture is found EIGHT times in the Bible. It is a verse like no other.
- It is found in Psalms, Matthew, Mark, Luke, Acts, First Corinthians and twice in Hebrews.
- **YOUR ENEMIES will be YOUR FOOTSTOOL!**
- All the enemies of the Lord had to be dealt with and completely consumed



- God is not going to rest until **our enemies are under our feet!**
- The zeal of Jehu isn't just an old bedtime story, **it is a picture of the zeal of Jesus!**
- Remember when he **cleansed** the temple?
- **Did you know that Jesus cleansed the temple at the beginning of his ministry and at the end?**
- John 2 and Matthews 21
 - For the **zeal of thine house** hath eaten me up; and **the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.** Psalms 69:9



- Jesus cleansed the temple because of his zeal.
- Who's the temple? **WE ARE!**
- So, this picture of Jehu, very zealous, very jealous, full of tremendous passion to do the will of God is a picture of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, the righteous king, the righteous judge.
- One thing I hope you have learned about these Old Testament stories – EVERY story points to JESUS!
- **Every miracle is about JESUS!**
- If you haven't learned anything else from these two series, then please learn that everything in every book of the Bible is about JESUS.



- **Everything is about HIM.**
- It all points to JESUS. It's all about HIM.
 - For of him, and through him, and to him, *are* all things: to whom *be* glory for ever. Amen. Romans 11:36
- Even in those moments of weakness in each of our lives, **the Lord Jesus Christ is zealous and jealous.**
- He said, “You are mine. I’m not going to have any other god, any other king, any other spirit have you. You are my property. I bought you!”
 - For when **they** shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction **cometh upon them**, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
1 Thessalonians 5:3



- Here's Joram, Ahaziah, Ahab's relatives, representing the old order.
- They have no idea they are about to be judged and put to death and executed.
- So, Joram says, **"Make ready. Hitch up the chariot"**.
- These two, **Ahaziah of Judah** and Uncle **Joram of Israel** were another unholy alliance. We talked about unholy alliances in Message 1 of this series.
- In that message we talked about how Ahab had made an alliance with King Jehoshaphat of Judah.
- Joram learned the art of compromise from his wicked father.



- In verse 21 of 2 Kings 9, they went out against Jehu, and they met him where?
- **Every one of us will meet Jesus in this place.** It was the portion of Naboth.
- **If there is anyplace in your life that an unrighteous thing has been done by you, you are going to meet Jehu there.**
- Jehu is coming now to deal with everything we have not allowed him to deal with up to this point.
- The very sight of this ground was menacing and preordained to make Joram tremble and Jehu triumph.





- Verse 22 Joram asked Jehu, “Is it peace?”
- Jehu responds, “What peace, so long as the **whoredoms** of thy mother **Jezebel** and her **witchcrafts** *are* so many?”
- This pictures all of Babylon’s religious clicks, tribal groups, and sexual whoredoms.
- It covers the obscene idol worship and monstrous sorceries.
 - *There is* no peace, saith the LORD, unto the wicked. Isaiah 48:22
 - For to be **carnally minded is death**; but **to be spiritually minded is life and peace.** Romans 8:6



- Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the **great whore** that sitteth upon many waters.
Revelation 17:1
- The word “**GREAT**” means “megas”, like a MEGAPHONE.
- It means BIG in external FORM and **APPEARANCE**.
- **That’s the religious systems.**
- This great **WHORE** sits on many waters, representing the unregenerate humanity.
 - But the wicked *are* like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt. Isaiah 57:20

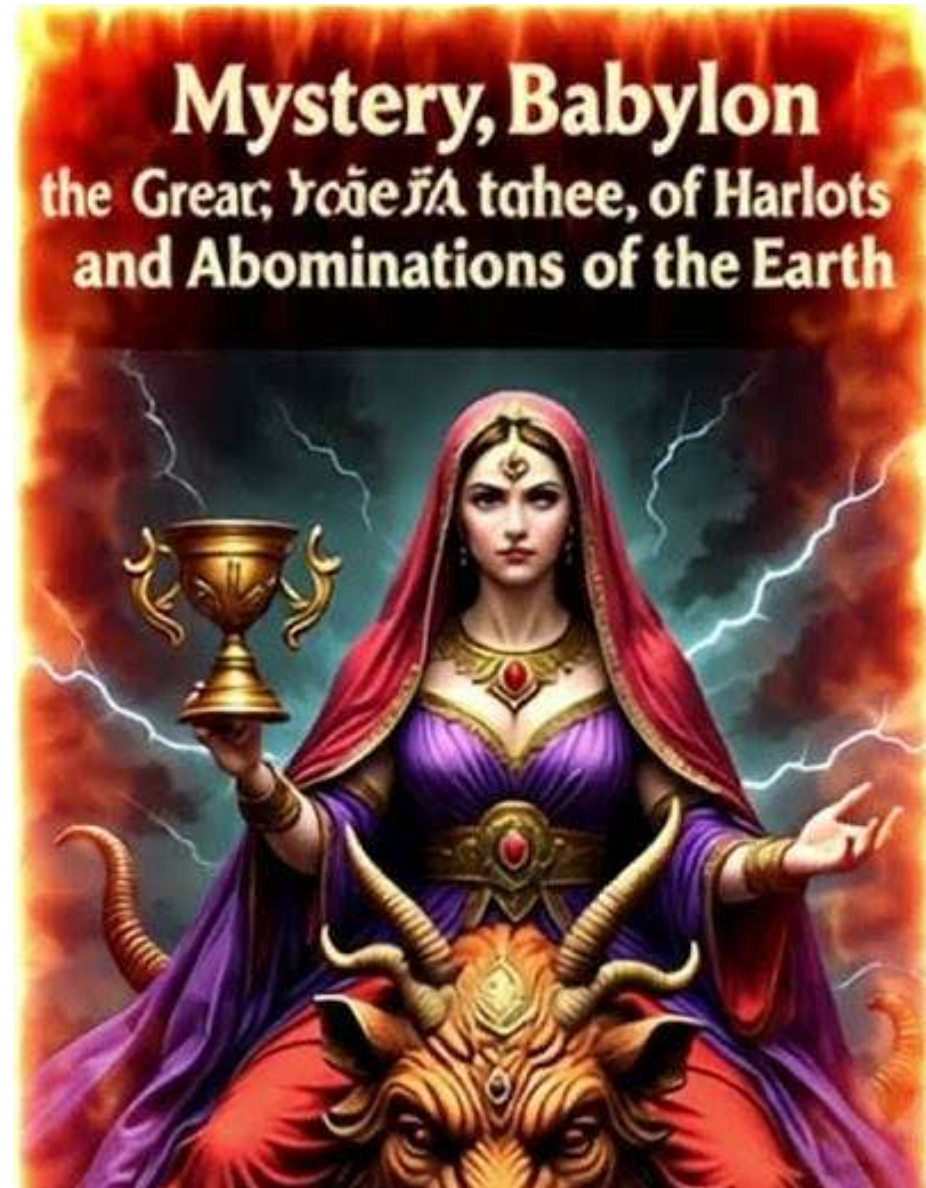
- With whom **the kings of the earth have committed fornication**, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication. Revelation 17:2
- Fornication here means to act the harlot.
- So **he carried me away in the spirit**. Revelation 17:3
- **You can only see this thing by the Spirit.**
- There is a **harlot** and there is a **bride**.
- You can only see both by being **carried away and seeing it in the spirit**.



- And I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet-coloured beast. Revelation 17:3
- The **woman** is **JEZEBEL**.
- She's sitting upon a scarlet covered beast.
- The **beast** is **AHAB**.
 - And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, **having a golden cup in her hand** full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication. Revelation 17:4
- The **golden cup** representing transubstantiation and the Roman Eucharist.
- Do you notice the pull today to merge and become one with Roman Catholicism and other "isms"?



- And upon her forehead *was* a name written, **MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.**
Revelation 17:5
- Her **forehead** is her **MINDSET**.
- Her **mindset** was a **NAME**, a **NATURE** of harlots and abominations.
 - And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. Revelation 17:6
- This is comparable to the blood of the Old Testament prophets of Jezebel's hand and the blood of Naboth.
- Admiration means to **GAZE**, to **MARVEL**, amazement, great astonished and wonderment.





- **Historically**, the mother of harlots is the Roman Catholic Church and all her Protestant **daughters** and **granddaughters**, but that's not the only application.
- **Babylon is a SPIRIT.**
- Elijah and Elisha **spoke a word** that brought the **demise** of Jezebel.
- This is not a reference to particular Godly people who **maybe God is using within the system**; for example, God put **Isaiah** and Daniel in the palace of the Babylonian system.
- **Jeremiah** preached to the remnant of Judah in Jerusalem.
- **Ezekiel** preached to the captives in Babylon at the same time.
- **God has real prophets at work in Babylon.**

- Often, we hear that everyone else or **particular people** are Babylon.
- The word “Jezebel” has been used to refer to **makeup** on women instead of a spirit.
- These are examples of **ignorance** and **abuse**.
- Babylon means “**gate of the gods**” and “**confusion**”.
- **Babylon is religious confusion.**
- We can **all** have some of that in our heads.
- **Moses** and **Elijah** are representative of the two witness of Revelation 11.
- **Moses** brought the people out of Egypt; but Elijah got the **Egypt** out of the people.



- **Historically**, with each of our lives, almost all of us have grown up in these **Babylonian religious systems**.
- There is more of this spirit **in us** than we are often willing to admit.
- What we view the church as, how we have **church**, our **ideas**, our **concepts**, there's a lot of **Babylon** in us.
- **It's in me and it's in you.**
- **Babylon** is a **spirit** and the **Elijah** ministry is a ministry of **fire**.
- **The fire of the prophetic word is here to burn up the Babylonian spirit within us.**



- What peace, so long as the whoredoms of thy mother Jezebel and her **witchcrafts** are so many?
2 Kings 9:234
- “Witchcraft” means “**Sorceries**”; to whisper a spell; to enchant or practice magic, used to describe the sorcerers of Egypt.”
 - Thou shalt not suffer a **witch** to live. Exodus 22:18
 - For rebellion *is* as the sin of **witchcraft**, and stubbornness *is* as iniquity and idolatry. 1 Samuel 15:23
- One of the works of the flesh is witchcraft. (Galatians 5:20)



- The Greek word for “**witchcraft**” is “**pharmakeia**”.
- “**Pharmakeia**” means “**medication**.”
- There’s a lot of **drug addicts in the church**. Just go home and look in their medicine cabinet.
- I’m not teaching against medicine, but rather the **abuse** of it.
- Some children don’t have to go on the streets to get it, they just open the medicine cabinet at home.
- **A lot of Christians are medicated on things besides what is in the medicine cabinet.**
- Many come to church to be **entertained**. That’s their medication.
- Many like a **certain style of teaching**. They have their **favorite** preacher. That’s their fix.



- A merry heart doeth good *like* a **medicine**. Proverbs 17:22
- What heals you? The **JOY** of the Lord.
- Are you are looking to something **outside of Him** as an external source for your medication?
- Do you need to be preached to in order to be happy?
- Do you need to “get your praise on”?
- What is your medication?
- **If it is anything outside of Jesus Christ, you are practicing sorcery.**
- The Greek word also means the use or administration of drugs or poison.

A merry heart
does good, like
medicine.

—Proverbs 17:22b



- The root word means a drug, a spell-giving potion, a **druggist**, or a **poisoner**.
- **A lot of preachers are drug dealers.**
- And the greatest **terrorists** in the world are not from the far east, they are from the **pulpits in America.**
- Many are **fearmongers.**
- **Any belief system, theology, or eschatology based on a spirit of fear is not of God.**
- You may say, “Well, it brings people to the Lord”.
- No, it scares the hell out of them.



- You may say, “It brings them to the altar.”
- Yeah, they **shed some tears** and their **emotions are moved**, but **it never touches their will.**
- **There is no birth. They are stillborn in the spirit.**
- Then we expect these people to **live** for God and they can’t, **because there is no new nature.**
- **Sorcery**, the use of drugs, whether simple or potent, was generally accompanied by **incantations** and **appeals** to **occult** powers with the provision of various **charms** and **amulets.**
- **Every denomination has their own.**
- **Mysterious resources** and powers were used by the **sorcerer** to impress and to divert the attention away from the **power** of the participating **demons.**

Spiritual Stillbirth



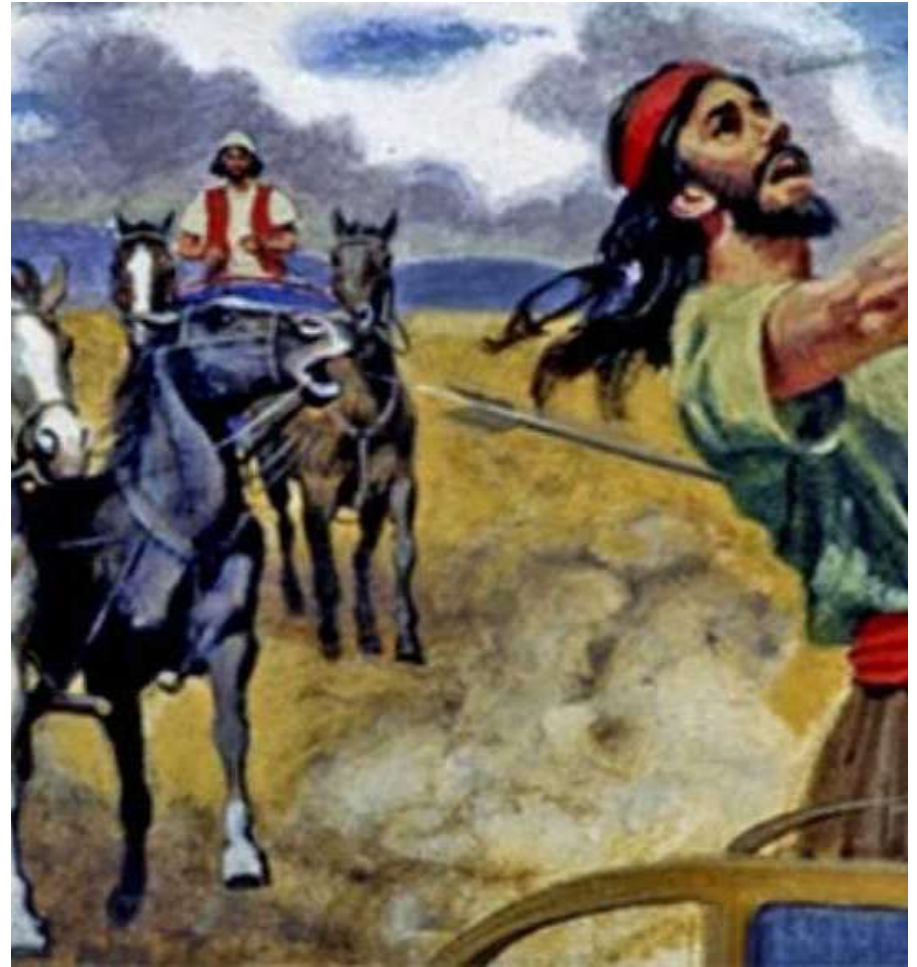
- Some may say, “**That preacher just mesmerized me.**”
- They cast a spell on you.
- Remember the “seven rays” General Flynn prayer. There was a **spell cast over the audience.**
- The **flag with the hexagram casts a spell.**
- Often, there are women who specifically follow pastors who are good-looking. They often want prayer or private meetings. They use their charms. This is sorcery.



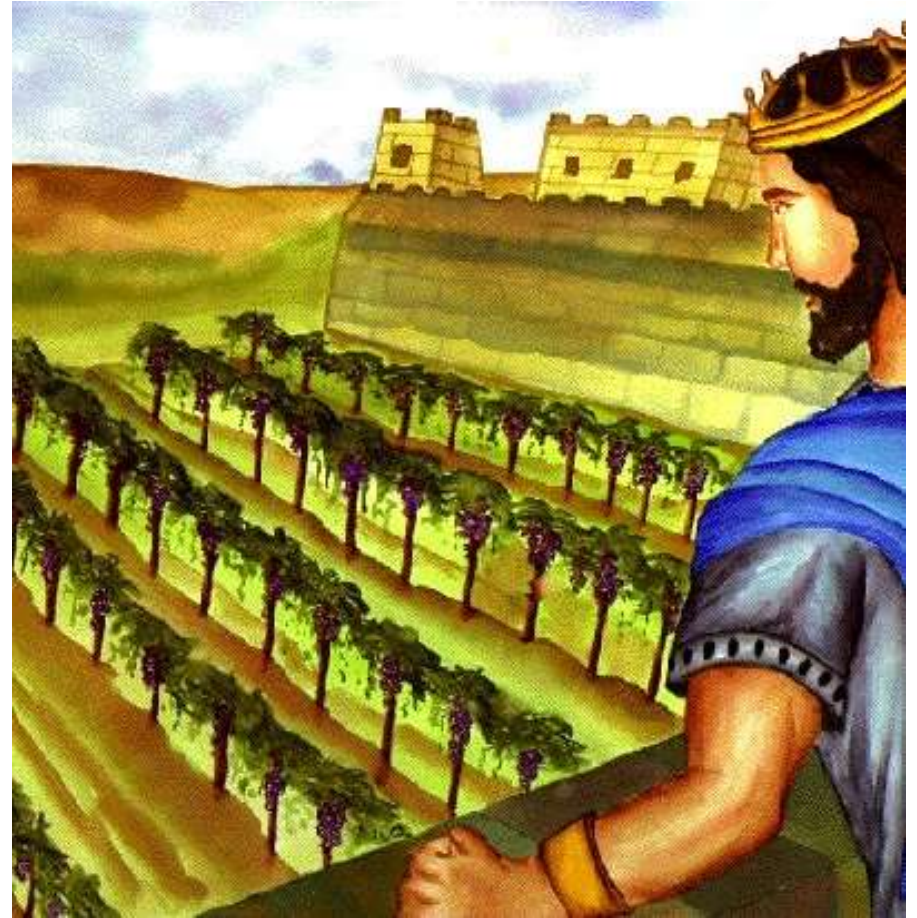
- Revelation 18 speaks about the Jezebel system.
 - with violence shall **that great city Babylon be thrown down**, and shall be found no more at all...the **light** of a **candle shall shine no more** at all in thee, and the voice of the bridegroom (JESUS) and of the bride (church) shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy **sorceries** were all nations deceived. Revelation 18:21,23
 - The **SPIRIT** of man is the **CANDLE** of the **LORD**. Proverbs 20:27
 - “Deceived” means “caused to roam from safety, truth, virtue; to be seduced or led astray into error or sin.”
- That’s what the Jezebel system does.



- Joram turned to Ahaziah and said, “**This is treachery, deceit, fraud.**”
- **Jehu drew the bow with his full strength and pierced through Joram’s heart.**
- Joram sunk down **dead** in the chariot.
 - Then said *Jehu* to Bidkar his captain, Take up, *and cast him in the portion of the field of Naboth the Jezreelite*: for remember how that, when I and thou rode together after Ahab his father, the LORD laid this burden upon him. 2 Kings 9:25
- What justice!
- They took the Joram, the son of Ahab who had murdered Naboth, right there in Naboth’s vineyard, and **threw him in the vineyard his mother and father had stolen.** It was where his parents had murdered Naboth.
- Jehu said the Lord laid this burden on Ahab which was an announcement of doom when God said to Ahab, “I’m not going to judge you or bring evil in your days, **but I will bring it on your son.**”
- And here it happened.



- Bidkar, Jehu's captain's name means "son of stabbing."
 - This was fitting justice to avenge Naboth's murder who had been stabbed in the back by the treachery of Ahab and Jezebel.
 - Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. Galatians 6:7
 - Surely I have seen yesterday the blood of Naboth, and the blood of his sons, saith the LORD; and **I will requite thee in this plat**, saith the LORD. **Now therefore take *and* cast him into the plat of *ground***, according to the word of the LORD. 2 Kings 9:26
 - Joram was repaid on the very property his parents had stolen.
 - It had been 25 years since Elijah prophesied this.

- Twenty-five years prior, Elijah had gone down to Naboth's vineyard and spoke to Ahab. He prophesied this would happen.
- And now it happened.
- But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw *this*, he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. *And they did* so at the going up to Gur, which *is* by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.
- And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem, and buried him in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David. 2 Kings 9:27-28



- 1 Kings 22 tells of the death of Ahab.
- And now we come to the demise and death of Jezebel, Ahab's wicked wife.
- Her death was foretold by Elijah, confirmed by Elisha.
- Now we are going to switch back over to Revelation 18.
- Every time you hear the word, "**her**" and the word, "**she**" or "**Babylon** the harlot", think of "**Jezebel** the harlot"
 - And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, **Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen**, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.
 - For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of **her** fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with **her**, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of **her** delicacies. Revelation 8:2-3
- Where would the businesspeople be without Christmas and Easter?



- And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of **her**, my people, that ye be not partakers of **her** sins, and that ye receive not of **her** plagues. Revelation 18:4
- Partakers means “in fellowship with, accompanying her, married to her.”
 - For **her sins** have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities (wrongdoings, misdeeds).
 - Reward **her** even as she rewarded you, and **double unto her double (double portion anointing)** according to her works: **in the cup** which **she** hath filled fill to her **double**. Relations 18:5-6
- **The communion cup has been abused.**



- How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, **I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.** Revelations 18:7
- **Pope Boniface VIII** declared in his 1302 *Ex Cathedra* Papal Bull that it is "absolutely necessary for the salvation of every human creature **to be subject to the Roman Pontiff,**" and that **outside the Roman Catholic Church, there is neither salvation nor the remission of sins.**
- This is anti-Christ.
- Millions worship the beast. How much she has glorified (praised, extolled, magnified, celebrated, honored, lived deliciously, wantingly, or luxuriously) herself.
- Like Jezebel, she said, "I sit as a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow."
- Ahab was dead.
- This is the "nobody can touch me" spirit.



- It was a historic meeting which included Joel Osteen, mormon Senator Mike Lee, and Israeli and Muslim leaders. They all joined in prayer. The pope himself prayed to Allah, the god of Islam.
- Joel Osteen said, "I like the fact that the pope is trying to make the Church larger, not smaller. He's not pushing people out but making the Church more inclusive. That resonated with me."
- Pope Francis said in a speech given in Rome on June 25, 2014, that individual salvation doesn't exist outside the Roman Catholic Church.
- He also stated that no one becomes a Christian on "his or her own. Is that clear?"
- The pope has also met with James Robinson, Kenneth Copeland, and several others that one might find surprising. Why would these people and the others mentioned earlier meet with a pope who says that the Catholic Church is the only way to salvation?

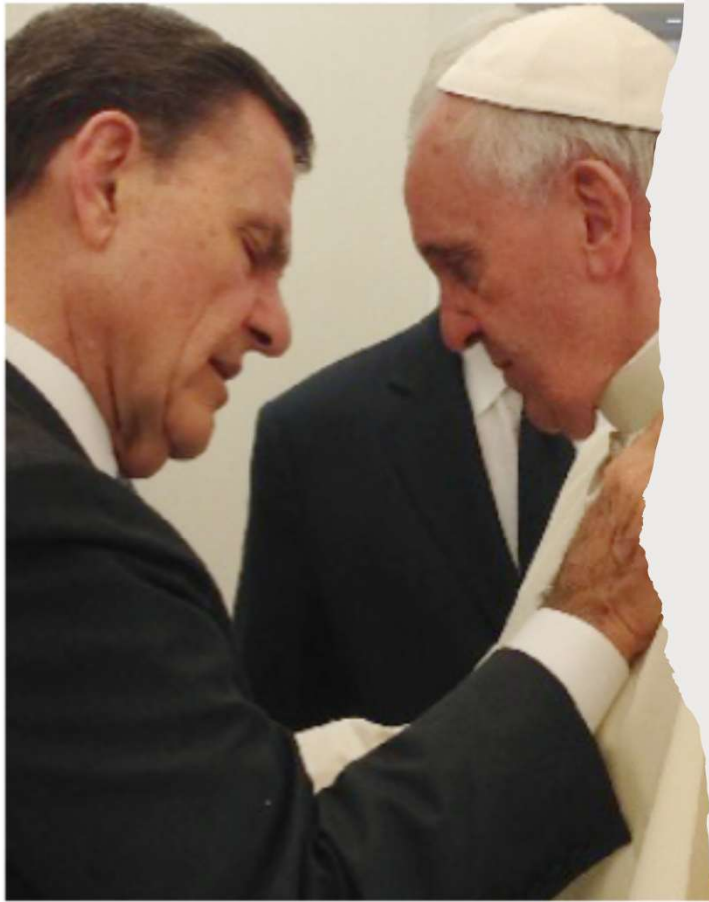

- Therefore shall **her** plagues (her blow, her stroke, **her** wound, her public calamity) **come in one day, death, and mourning,** and famine; and **she** shall be utterly **burned with fire:** for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her. Revelation 18:8
- Burned with what?
 - And when Jehu was come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard *of it*; and she painted her face, and tired her head, and looked out at a window. 2 Kings 9:30
- She put black powder paint dye on her eyes up and down.
- She tired her head. She put ornaments, a tiara turban headdress on.
- She looked out the window (and posed seductively).
- What arrogance. He just killed her son, but she didn't care.



- The **SYSTEM** has no love for the true preachers.
- They only care about the **SYSTEM**.
- Those who pastor a local church, most like the **denomination** owns the property.
- Preachers are absolutely slaves to the **SYSTEM**.
- They are company men. You know why?
- **Their pensions are connected with it.**
- Many denominations move their pastors around like pawns on a chessboard. It's all **POLITICAL**.



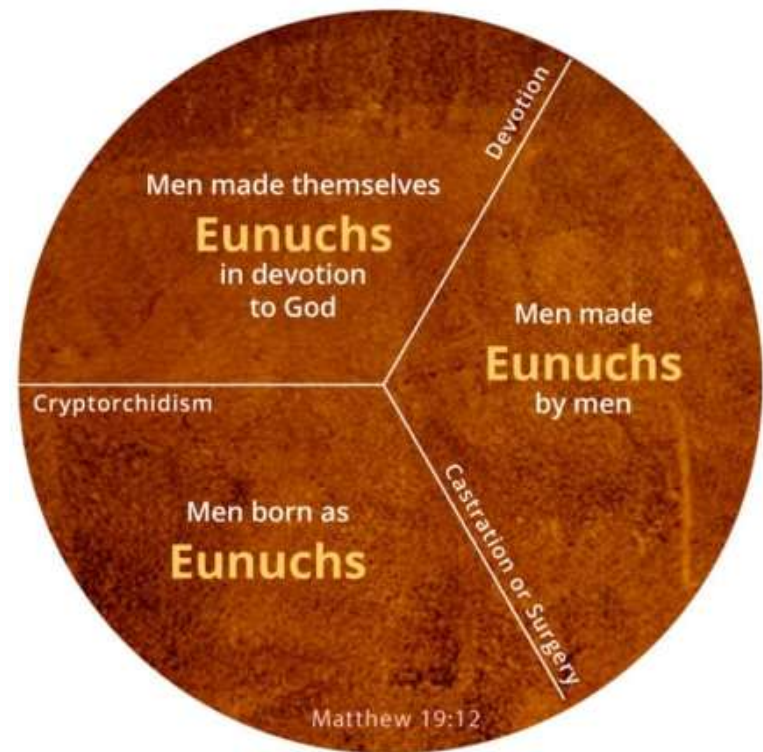
- Jezebel is sitting seductively at the window, and Jehu is coming down the road **driving furiously**.
- As Jehu entered the gate, Jezebel tried to **intimate** him by calling him a murderer.
 - And as Jehu entered in at the gate, she said, *Had Zimri peace, who slew his master?*
 - And he lifted up his face to the window, and said, **Who is on my side? who? And there looked out to him two or three eunuchs.** 2 Kings 9:31-32
- Jehu looked up and said, “Who is on my side?”
 - Remember this is a picture of Jesus.



- Who listening is on Jesus' side?
- I'm not talking about denominations. **I'm talking about who is holy?**
- When Jehu asked this, "And there looked out to him two or three eunuchs".
 - Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, **Who is on the LORD'S side?** *let him come* unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him. Exodus 32:26
 - Who will rise up for me **against the evildoers?** *or* who will stand up for me **against the workers of iniquity?** Psalm 94:16
 - For thus **saith the LORD unto the eunuchs** that keep my sabbaths, and choose *the things* that please me, and take hold of my covenant;
 - Even unto them will **I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off.** Isaiah 56:4-5



- There are three kinds of eunuchs in Matthew 19:12
 - Those **who are born** eunuchs.
 - Those **who are made** eunuchs, emasculated and castrated by religious systems **can never produce the Kingdom of God.**
 - Those who **made themselves** eunuchs. These can't produce **anything but the Kingdom of God.**
 - For there are some eunuchs, **which were so born** from *their* mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, **which were made** eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which **have made themselves** eunuchs **for the kingdom of heaven's sake.** He that is able to receive *it*, let him receive *it*.
- Jehu asked, "Is there anybody up there on the Lord's side?"
- And two or three eunuchs looked out.



Three Types of Eunuchs

- And he (Jehu) said, **Throw her down** (no hesitation, fling her down, release her, let her drop). So they threw her down: and *some* of her blood was sprinkled on the wall, and on the horses: and he trode her under foot. 2 Kings 9:33
- **This is an overthrow of Babylon.**
- One ancient way of dealing with wrongdoers was to **throw them down from a high place** and then stone them.
- So, they threw her down.
- When the Lord Jesus wants to deal with something in your life, and we **argue** and we **barter** and we **rationalize**, and we tell him that our mother and daddy was like us and it runs in our family; **the Lord Jesus may just throw it down.**



- When they threw her down some of her blood, that is **her life**, was sprinkled, literally spurted or splattered on the wall and on the horses and they trampled her underfoot.
 - Behold, I give unto you **power to tread on serpents and scorpions**, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19
 - And the God of peace shall **bruise Satan under your feet shortly**. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen. Romans 16:20
- **Throw her down! Throw that which is Babylon down!**



**BEHOLD, I GIVE UNTO YOU

- And when he was come in, **he did eat and drink**, and said, Go, see now this cursed *woman*, and bury her: for she is a king's daughter. 2 Kings 9:34
- They had a party.
 - Rejoice over her, *thou* heaven, and ye **holy apostles** and **prophets**; for **God hath avenged you on her**. Revelation 18:20
- Jehu said take this cursed woman and bury her: for she is a king's daughter.
- She was the daughter of the King of the Zidonians, wife to King Ahab and mother to King Joram.
- She was the daughter of a king, the wife of a king, and the mother of a king.

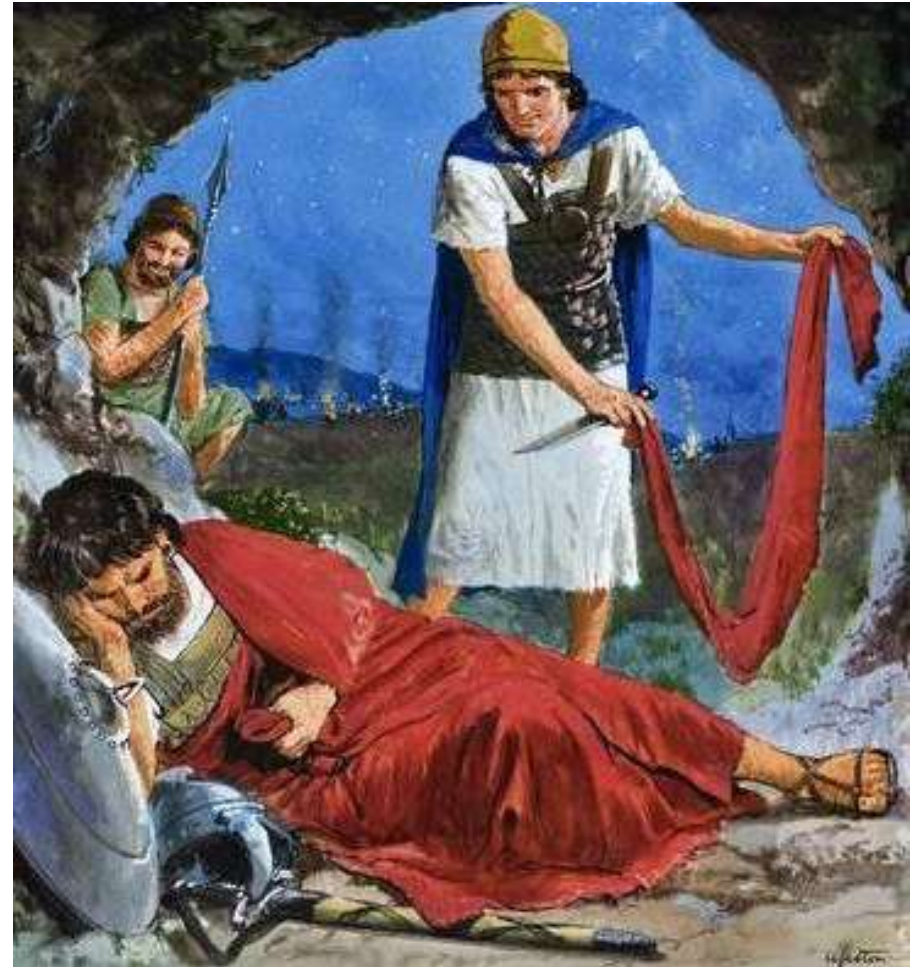
HE REMOVETH KINGS AND SETTETH UP KINGS

- God honors authority.
- **This woman was cursed, but she was a king's daughter.**
 - He removeth kings, and setteth up kings. *Daniel 2:21*
- This was the Satanic kingdom, but in the Kingdom of God, because God honors authority, there is a special judgement reserved for those who speak evil of dignities (God's anointed).
 - Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities. Jude 1:8
 - But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous *are they*, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. 2 Peter 2:10

Vengeance is mine; I will repay, says the Lord. – Romans 12:19.

- There's a special judgment reserved for children who mock their parents and for sheep who mock the true anointed.
- If you are anointed by God, you never have to retaliate.
- There are witches, warlocks and those who pray against God's anointed.
- If we are living a holy life, we can laugh at them. **We are Abraham's seed.** We are blessed. If they curse us, they will be cursed.
- We never have to retaliate or get even.
 - Vengeance *belongeth* unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. Hebrews 10:30
 - *It is* a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Hebrews 10:31
- When the half brothers come and eat corn out of my hand, the ones who threw me in the pit, I will have to go into another room and weep.
 - And Joseph made haste; for his bowels did yearn upon his brother: and he sought *where* to weep; and he entered into *his* chamber, and wept there. Genesis 43:30

- God honors authority, government, and office.
- Jezebel was a king's daughter.
- **She was demon possessed and Saul was demon possessed.**
 - And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, **Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee.** Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.
 - And it came to pass afterward, that **David's heart smote him**, because he had cut off Saul's skirt. 1 Samuel 24:4-5
- David cut off the skirt of Saul's robe.
- You know why David's heart smote him, his conscience bothered him?
- Because David was anointed to take the throne, and we can't have David coming to the throne with anything in his spirit that is wrong; otherwise, we would have another madman on the throne.
- Keep your heart pure and holy. Let God take the vengeance unless he has given you a Jehu anointing.



- If you are holding a grudge or unforgiveness in your spirit, it's cancer. It's poison.
- Unless you forgive the person, they have control over you.
- FEFE – forgive everyone for everything.
- Forgiveness is not agreeing or accepting wrong behavior.
- We have to guard our spirit and set boundaries.
- Some things done to us are unspeakable. We can't dwell on it but must confess it all to God and let Him heal us and take His vengeance.
- Almost everyone has had major hurt in their lives.
- Every parent has had children who have broken their heart.
- God's grace is here to heal us.
- If you are living in an abusive situation, you will want to seek God about your protection.
- I feel so strongly for the children who have no voice against abuse. It think many have experienced a “no voice as a child” and why many are rising up in this hour against the abuse of children.
- If it has been in the past, you may have triggers from those who have hurt you. Remember we are not completely saved yet. It is a progress. Listen to my “Sure Foundation” of the Overcomer series.



I'm praying for your deliverance from the power of those who have hurt you.

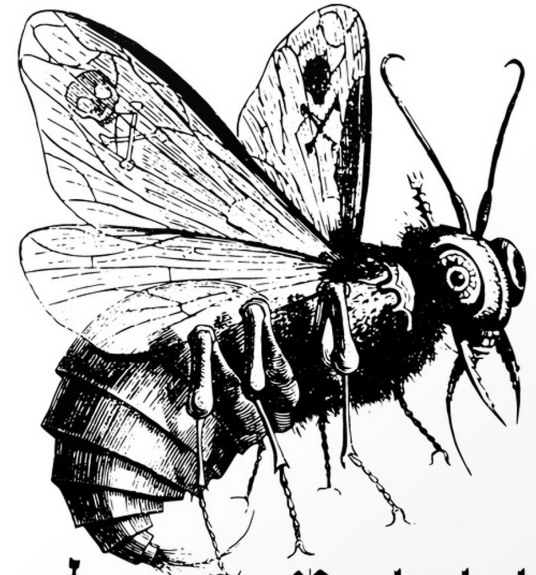
- And they went to bury her (Jezebel): but **they found no more of her** than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of *her* hands. 2 Kings 9:35
- The painted face of verse 30 was gone.
- **Nothing was there** but her hands, her feet, and her skull. The tips of her fingers were gone.
 - Behold, Dagon (a philistine god) *was* fallen upon his face to the ground before the ark of the LORD; and the head of Dagon and both the palms of his hands *were* cut off upon the threshold; **only the stump of Dagon was left to him.** 1 Samuel 5:4



- Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he (Elisha) said, This *is* the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant **Elijah** the Tishbite, **saying**, *In the portion of Jezreel shall **dogs eat the flesh** of Jezebel*: 2 Kings 9:36
- The word of Elijah killed her and confirmed by Elisha. It was prophesied
 - And of Jezebel also **spake the LORD**, saying, **The dogs shall eat Jezebel** by the wall of Jezreel. 1 Kings 21:23
 - And the dogs shall eat Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel, and *there shall be none to bury her*. And he opened the door, and fled. 2 Kings 9:10
- And the carcase of Jezebel **shall be as dung upon the face of the field** in the portion of Jezreel; so that they shall not say, This *is* Jezebel. 2 Kings 9:37
- Jezebel in, Jezebel out. She was as dog droppings.
- What happened to the flesh of Jezebel?
- The dogs ate her and the next day, they pooped her out.
- This was the word of the Lord. This is the attitude of God about the harlot system.



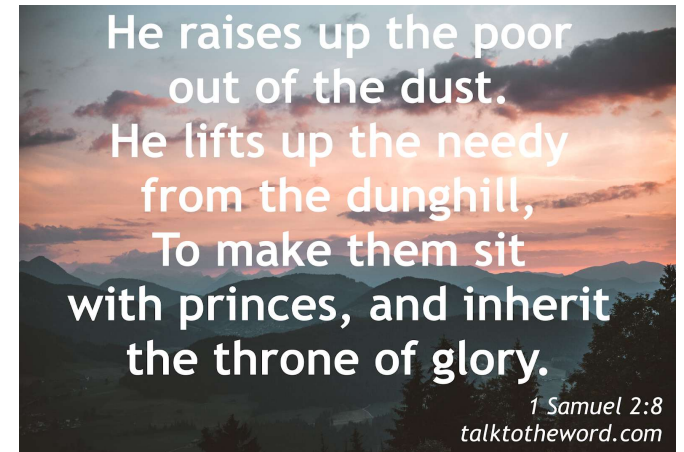
- When we stray away from the truth, we play the harlot with some other idea.
 - The righteous are bold as a lion. Proverbs 28:1 is truth.
- There's not a person listening who has not had a moment of fear.
- Fear is Jezebel.
- When are the righteous as bold as a lion? Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, everyday of the week.
- If you say, "I'm afraid...". That's Jezebel talking.
 - Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for **whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them *but* dung**, that I may win Christ. Philippians 3:8
- Paul is talking about his old life of religion – he counted it as dung.
- **Baalzebub** the master of flies – fly god, dung god.



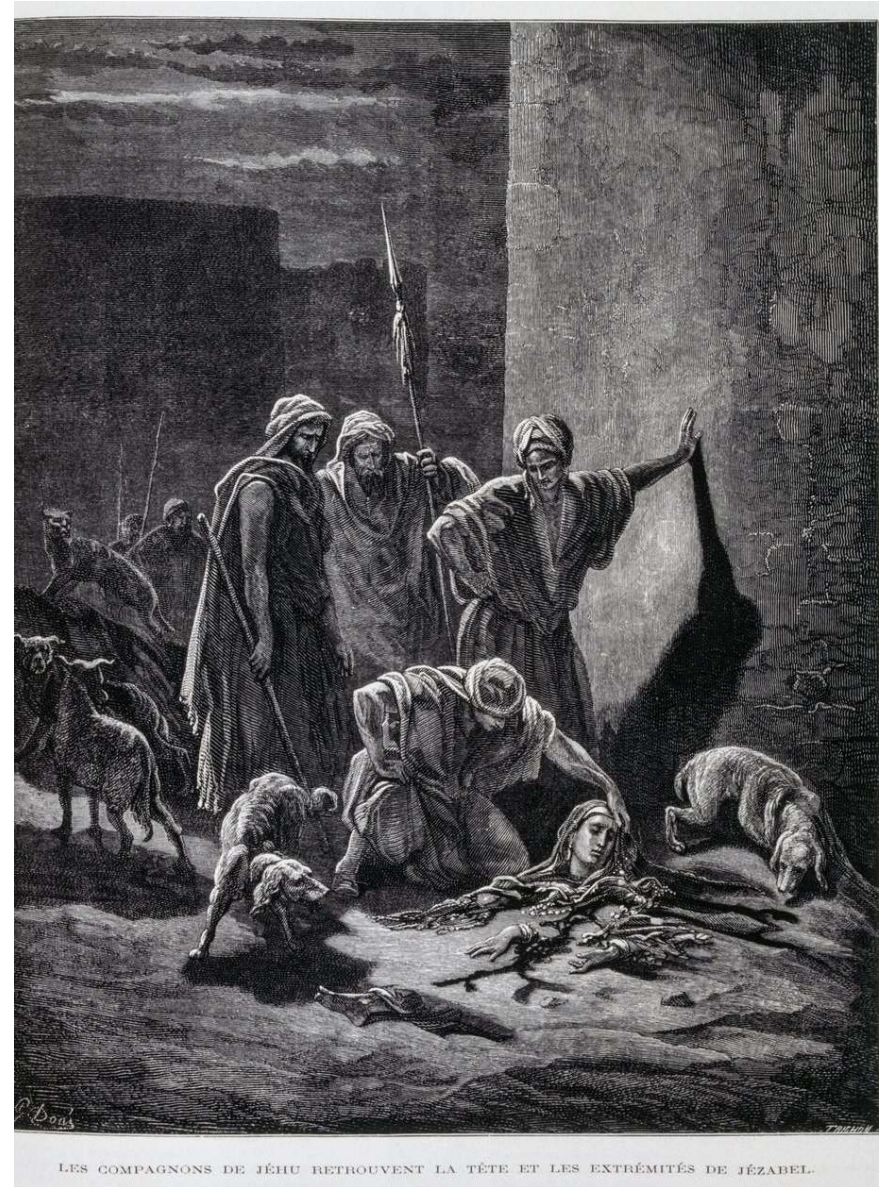

He Brought Me Out of the Crapper

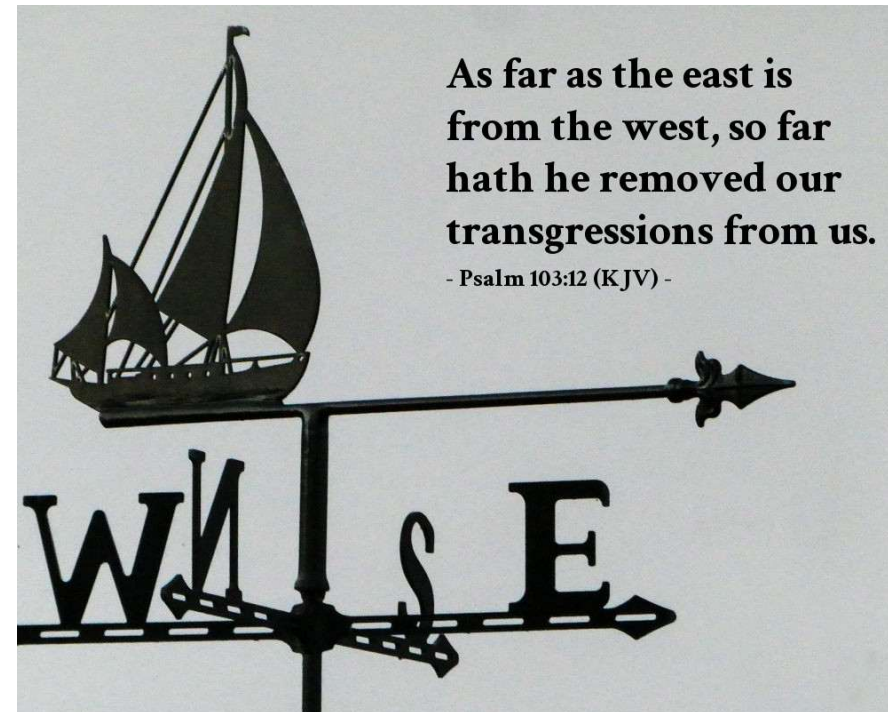
- **Zion is the Mountain of the Lord**
- The opposite of Zion is **Babylon**
- **Babylon is a DUNG HILL.**
- 1 Samuel 2:8 says that God has taken ALL of us and lifted us out of the dung hill to make us sit among princes.
 - Aren't you glad?
 - I used to live in the crapper – how about you?
- “He raiseth up the **poor** out of the dust, *and* lifteth up the **beggar** **from the dunghill, to set them among princes**, and to make them inherit the throne of glory.”



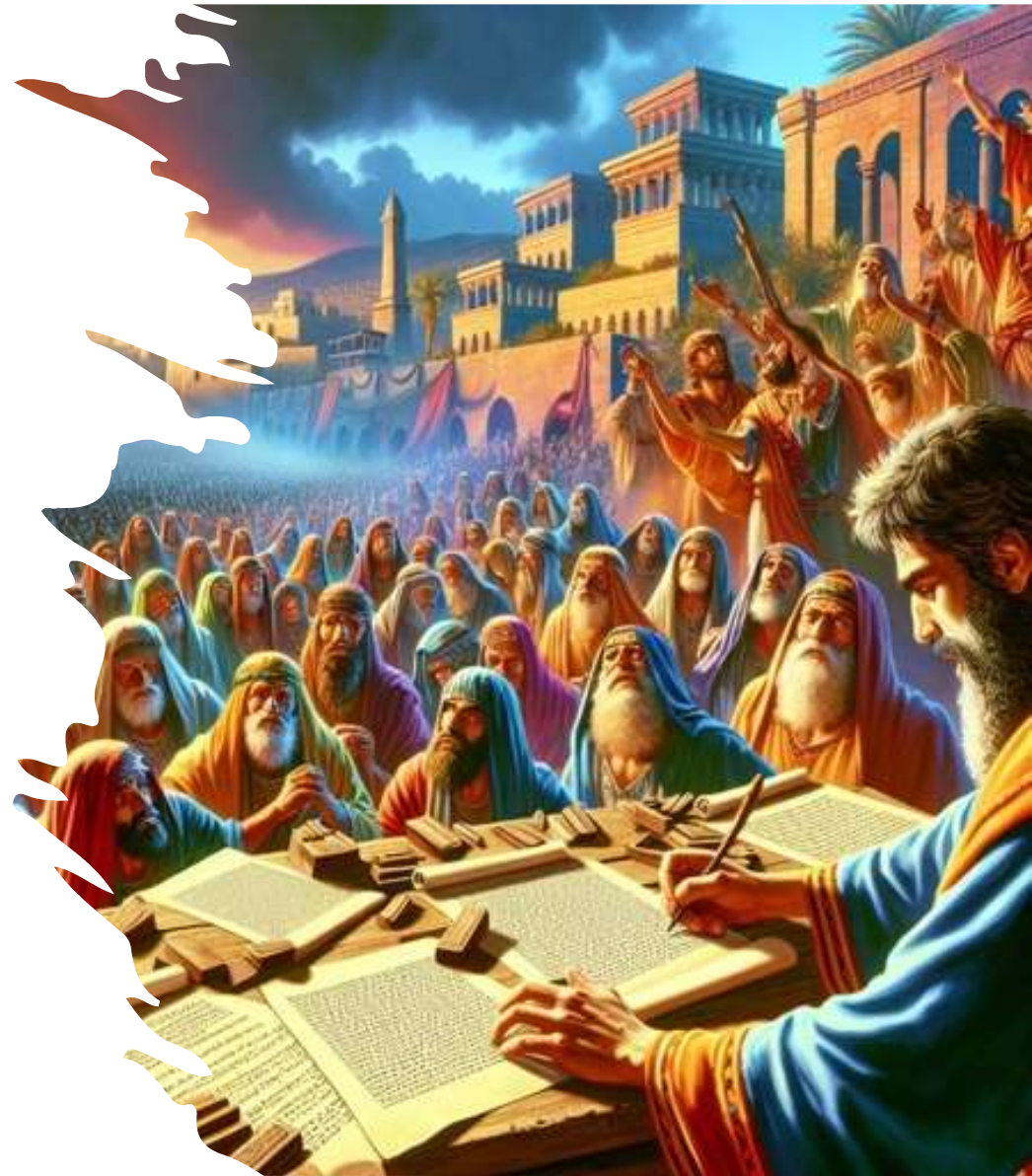
- What happened to Jezebel? What is her destiny?
- They went to bury her, but just found a skull, feet, and palms of the hands.
- The last verse said her corpse shall be as dung.
- See those dog droppings? That's Jezebel.
- No one can go and see where she is buried. **There is no memorial, no shrine.**
- In the culture of that day, kings were buried in a royal cemetery. The tombs of the kings were in Zion.
- There was no honor, no service for Jezebel. No memory.
 - Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem. Nehemiah 2:20



- When the enemies came up, Nehemiah turned and said, “There shall be no memorial of you in this city.”
- The things that have come against those who are God’s, **God is going to make it as dung.**
- It will be gone, no longer remembered.
 - I, *even I, am* he that **blotteth out** thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will **not remember** thy sins. Isaiah 43:25
 - As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us. Psalm 103:12
 - And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: **for the former things are passed away.** Revelation 21:4
- Thank God – no more Jezebel!



- The next section, 2 Kings 10, is the slaying of King Ahab's 70 sons. It is a gory story.
- Jehu wrote letters and said to the sons and grandsons of Ahab's seed and influence, you better look out among you and find the best one you have, the most qualified and put him on the throne and fight for your father's house, because I'm coming.
 - And Ahab had seventy sons in Samaria. And Jehu wrote letters, and sent to Samaria, unto the rulers of Jezreel, to the elders, and to them that brought up Ahab's *children*, saying,
 - Now as soon as this letter cometh to you, seeing your master's sons *are* with you, and *there are* with you chariots and horses, a fenced city also, and armour;
 - **Look even out** the best and meetest of your master's sons, and set *him* on his father's throne, and fight for your master's house. 2 Kings 10:1-3



- They were exceedingly afraid. **Jehu had already killed two kings, Joram and Aziah.**
 - But **they were exceedingly afraid**, and said, Behold, two kings stood not before him: how then shall we stand?
 - And he that was over the house, and he that was over the city, the elders also, and the bringers up of *the children*, sent to Jehu, saying, **We are thy servants, and will do all that thou shalt bid us**; we will not make any king: do thou *that which is good* in thine eyes. 2 Kings 10:4-5
- Jehu wrote to them a second time. He said, “Take the 70 sons and slay them and put their heads in baskets and bring them to Jezreel.”
 - Then he wrote a letter the second time to them, saying, If ye *be* mine, and *if* ye will hearken unto my voice, take ye the heads of the men your master's sons, and come to me to Jezreel by to morrow this time. Now the king's sons, *being* seventy persons, were with the great men of the city, which brought them up.
 - And it came to pass, when the letter came to them, **that they took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets**, and sent him *them* to Jezreel. 2 Kings 10:6-7



So, they did. They laid them in heaps at the entering of the gate.

- And there came a messenger, and told him (Jehu), saying, They have brought the heads of the king's sons. And he said, Lay ye them in two heaps at the entering in of the gate until the morning. 2 Kings 10:8

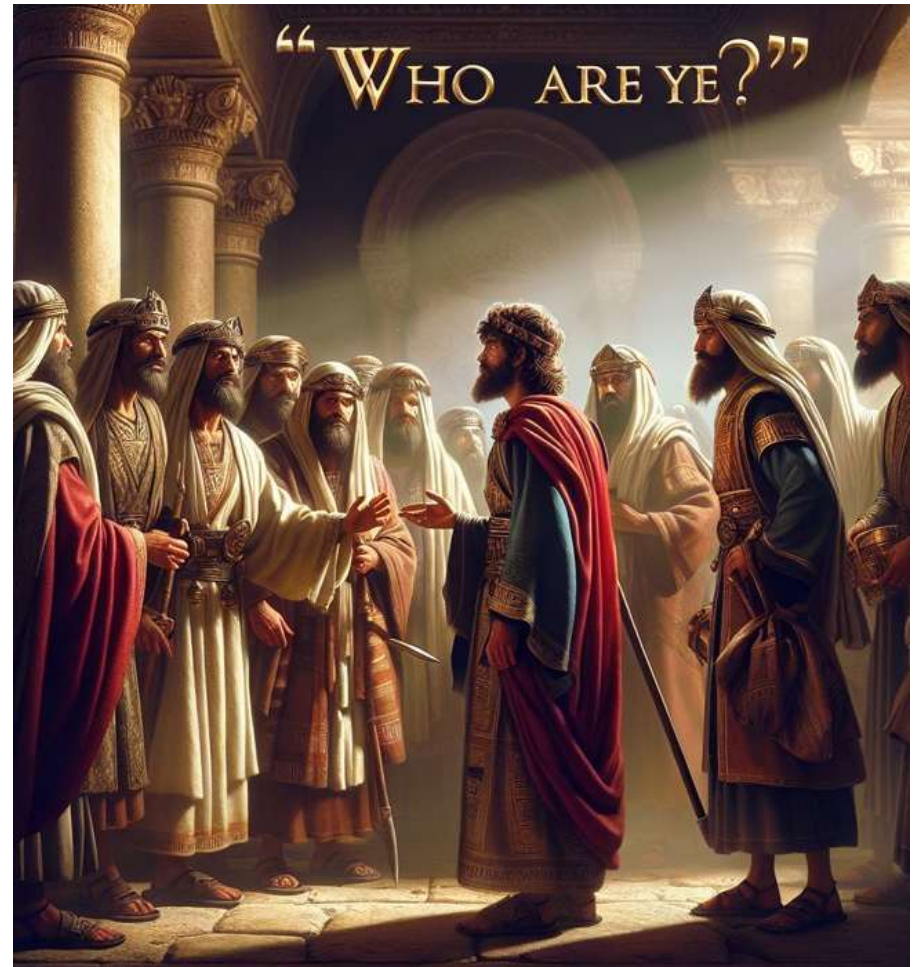
In the morning, Jehu said, "I didn't do this. Those other boys did."

- And it came to pass in the morning, that he went out, and stood, and said to all the people, Ye *be* righteous: behold, I conspired against my master, and slew him: but who slew all these? 2 Kings 10:9

Here it comes again of the word of the Lord which the Lord spake concerning the house of Ahab.

- **Know now that there shall fall unto the earth nothing of the word of the LORD**, which the LORD spake concerning the house of Ahab: for the LORD hath done *that* which he spake by his servant Elijah. 2 Kings 10:10

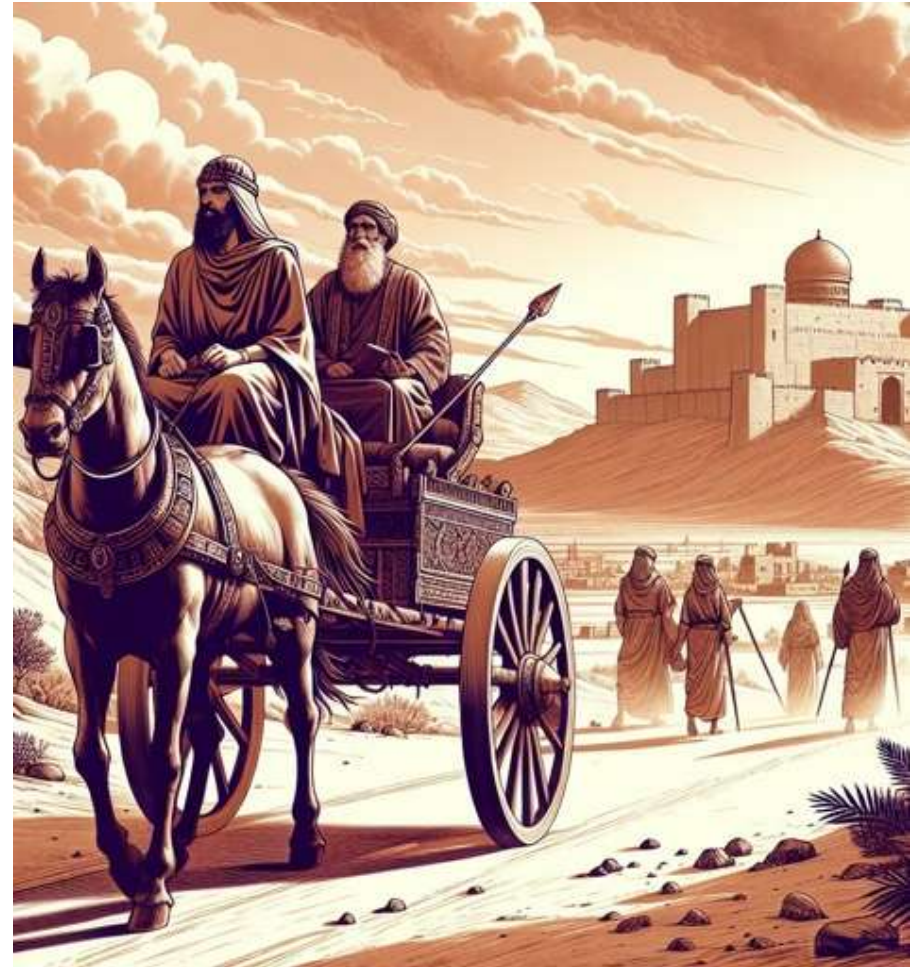
- **Everything** that Elijah and Elisha prophesied would happen, **happened**.
 - So, Jehu slew all that remained of the house of Ahab in Jezreel, and all his great men, and his kinsfolks, and his priests, until he left him none remaining. 2 Kings 10:11
- In 2 Kings 10:12:1-17 the same thing happened.
- Jehu was at the shearing house which was an appropriate place.
- He met the brethren of Ahaziah and said, “Who are you?”
 - And he arose and departed, and came to Samaria. *And as he was* at the shearing house in the way,
 - Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, *Who are ye?* And they answered, *We are* the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.
 - And he said, Take them alive. And **they took them alive, and slew them** at the pit of the shearing house, *even* two and forty men; neither left he any of them. 2 Kings 10:12-14



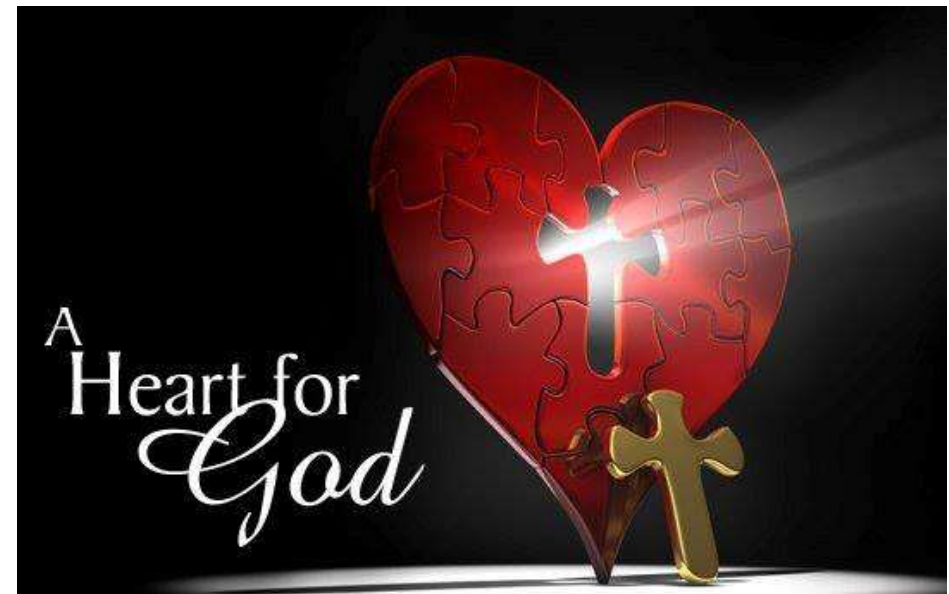
- Verse 15, Jehu meets a guy by the name of **Jehonadab** (Jehovah is willing), the son of Raechab which means “rider”.
- He says, “**Is your heart right? Is it loyal to mine?** Is it true to me? Is your mind as my heart?”
 - And when he was departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab *coming* to meet him: and he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart *is* with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give *me* thine hand. And **he gave him his hand; and he took him up to him into the chariot.** 2 Kings 10:15
- **What’s really happening here is that Jehu is involved in a nationwide reformation.**
- He is asking, “Are you a reformer?”
- Jehonadab, who was **a very righteous man**, a very **influential** man said, “I am”.
- So Jehu said, “Give me your hand”. And he took him up into the chariot.
 - **To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne**, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. Revelation 3:21
 - They that are with him *are* called, and chosen, and faithful. Revelation 17:14



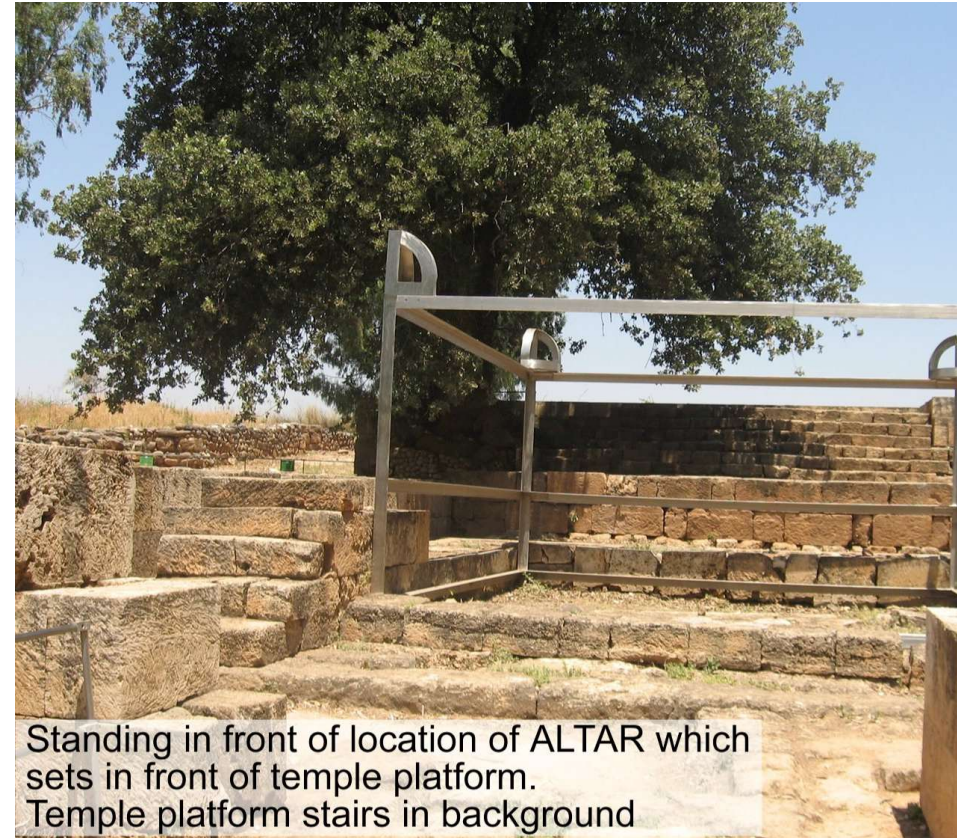
- In this story, Jehu is a picture of Jesus, **the righteous king coming to judge all wickedness**
- Jehu was a special man given a special place of honor to ride in the chariot.
 - **Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ.** 2 Corinthians 2:14
- It was a place of honor.
 - And he said, **Come with me, and see my zeal for the LORD.** So they made him ride in his chariot. 2 Kings 10:16
- The chariot in the Bible is a picture of the throne of God in motion.
- Jehu on his chariot is a picture of Jesus moving forth in the **throne**, his **authority**, his **government** coming in all the **power** of his name.
- Jehonadab is **a picture of the overcomer**. He was from a sect that was very strict, very holy, very separated.
- Tradition says the daughters of the Rechabites married the sons of the Levites and that their children were ministers in the temple.
- God separated this group of people.



- When Jehu asked this man to come up into the chariot and ride with him, it is a picture of those that Jesus is coming to now – those who have paid the price, those called **chosen** and **faithful**, and **holy**. Those who have kept themselves **clean**.
- Jehu said, “Is your heart with me?”
- That is the message. Jesus is coming now and saying, “**Is there anybody listening that your heart is with mine?**” “Are we one in Spirit?”
- The man never hesitated. He said, “**I am**”.
- Jehu said, “Come up into the chariot.”



- **Historically, Jehu was shrewd.** If we paint the picture of Jehu as **the man**, even though he was used to eradicate Baal worship, even though he is a type of our Lord Jesus Christ, the righteous judge, he himself was not completely righteous, as we will soon see.
- He did not put away the calves at Dan and Bethel. **He was shrewd, he was cunning.**
- There is no such thing as **a perfect type**. But he is a **picture** of Jesus in his coming and righteous judgement.
- However, **he did this for his own benefit** and he knew if he could get this guy who was one of the **most holy men** in the land and who was **influential** to team up with he could accomplish what he was destined to do.
- Everybody loved Jehonadab.
- He is riding with Jehu, and this thing is of God.



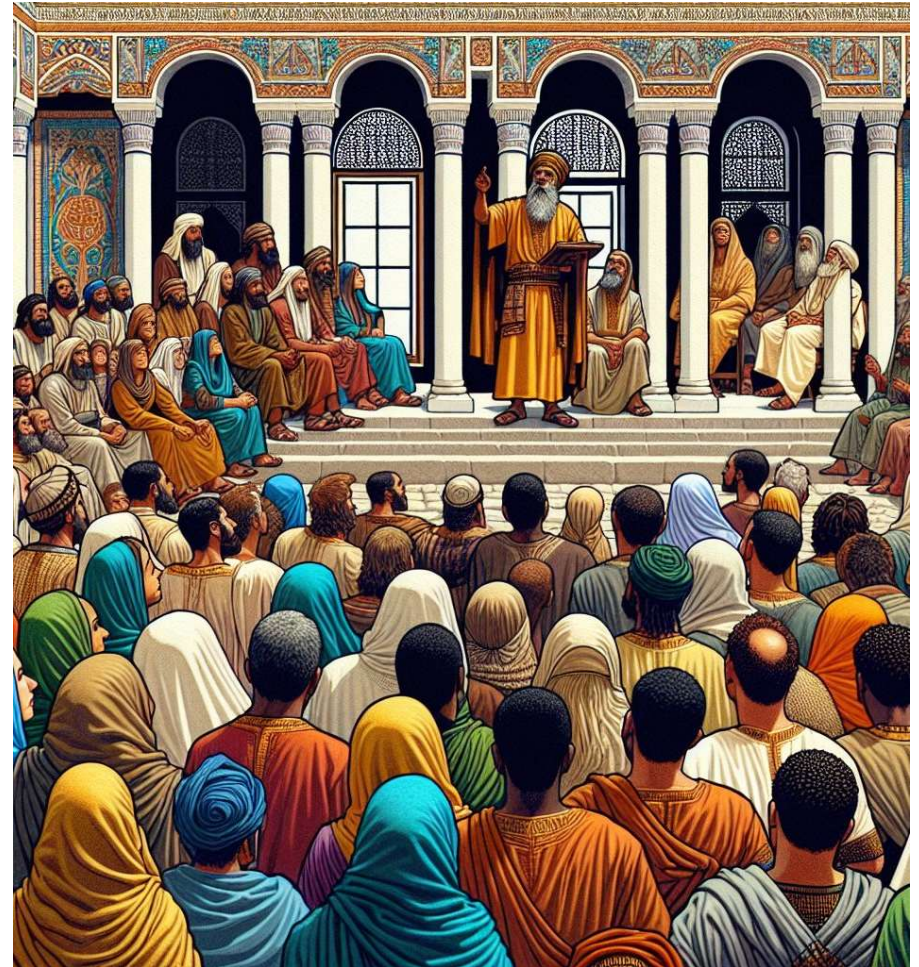
Standing in front of location of ALTAR which sets in front of temple platform.

- Jehonadab was a righteous man, the holy, separated man.
- Jehonadab wanted to get rid of Baal worship, Jezebel and all the above.
- So Jehonadab rode with Jehu.
- The question is, “**Is your heart with Jesus?**”
- **The only ones who ride with him have to have their heart with him.**
 - And he said, Come with me, and see my zeal for the LORD. So they made him ride in his chariot.
 - And when he came to Samaria, he slew all that remained unto Ahab in Samaria, till he had destroyed him, according to the saying of the LORD, which he spake to Elijah. 2 Kings 10:16-17

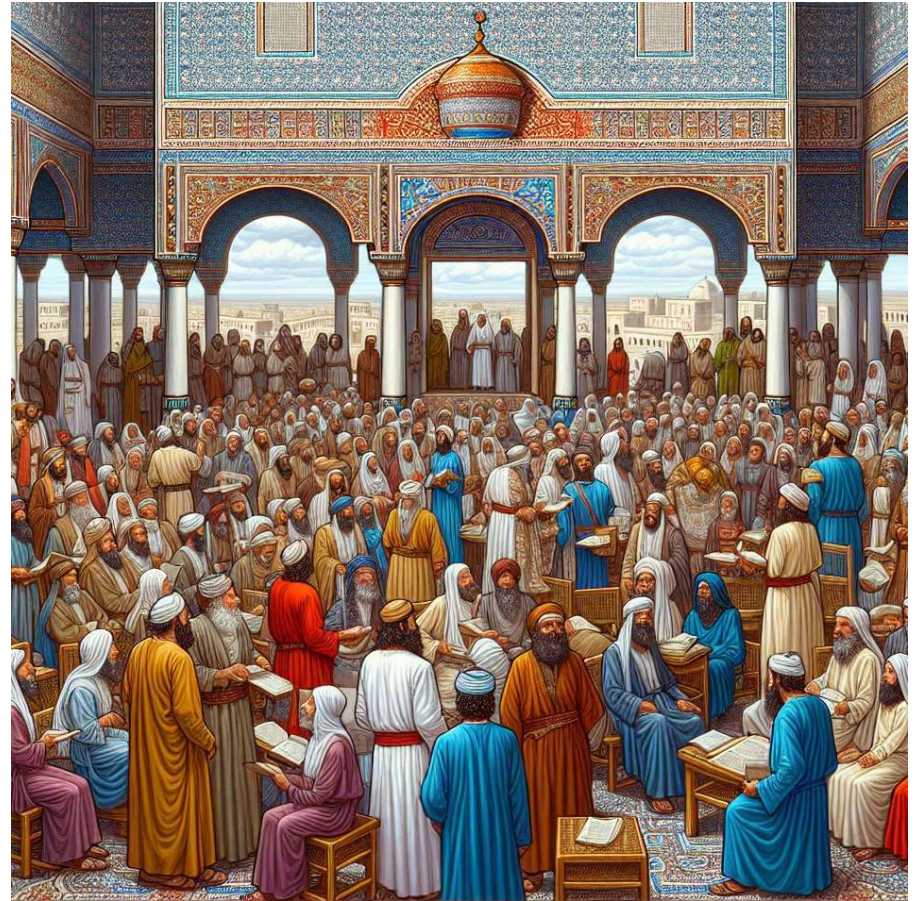

- 2 Kings 10 ends by showing **King Jehu's eradication of Baal worship.**
- There are many forms and temples of Baal.
 - And Jehu gathered all the people together, and said unto them, Ahab served Baal a little; *but* Jehu shall serve him much.
 - Now therefore call unto me all the prophets of Baal, all his servants, and all his priests; let none be wanting: for I have a great sacrifice *to do* to Baal; whosoever shall be wanting, he shall not live. But Jehu did *it* in subtilty, to the intent that he might destroy the worshippers of Baal. 2 Kings 10:18-10
- This was **an ecumenical movement**. He called all the **prophets** of Baal, **servants** of Baal, and the **priests** of Baal.
- He got them all together **subtly** with the intent to destroy them.
- He said, "Ahab served Baal small time, Jehu will serve him big time."

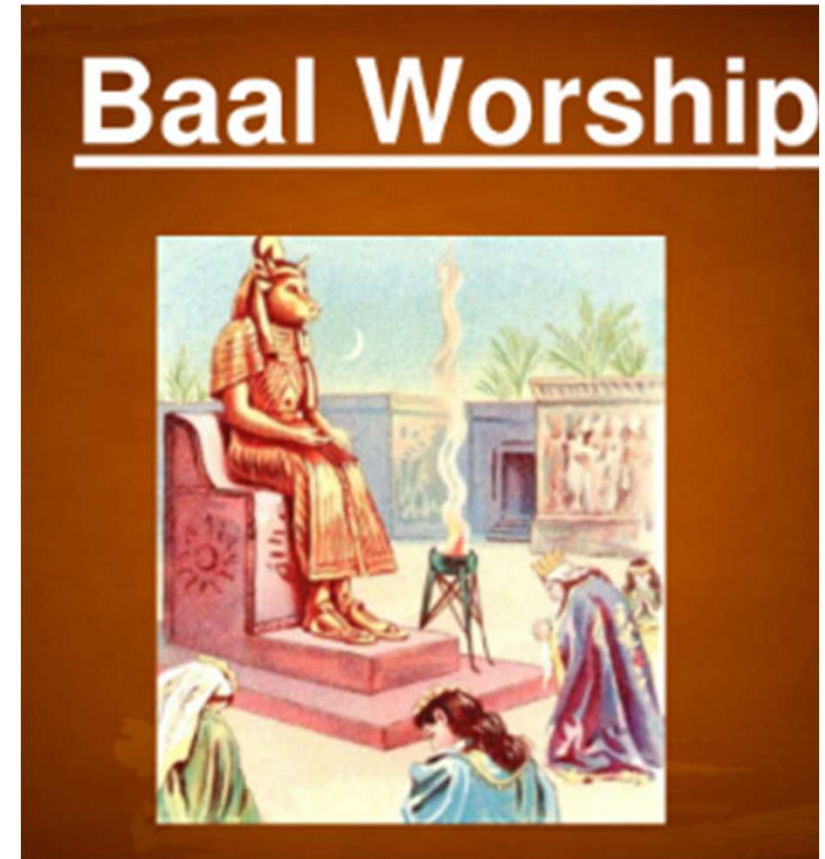


- He proclaimed a solemn assembly, a major convention.
 - And Jehu said, Proclaim a solemn assembly for Baal. And they proclaimed *it*.
 - And Jehu **sent through all Israel: and all the worshippers of Baal came**, so that there was not a man left that came not. And they came into the house of Baal; and the house of Baal was full from one end to another. 2 Kings 10:20-21
- Think of your major conventions and convocations all through America.
- The house of Baal was full from one end to the other. They packed the temple of Baal to capacity.

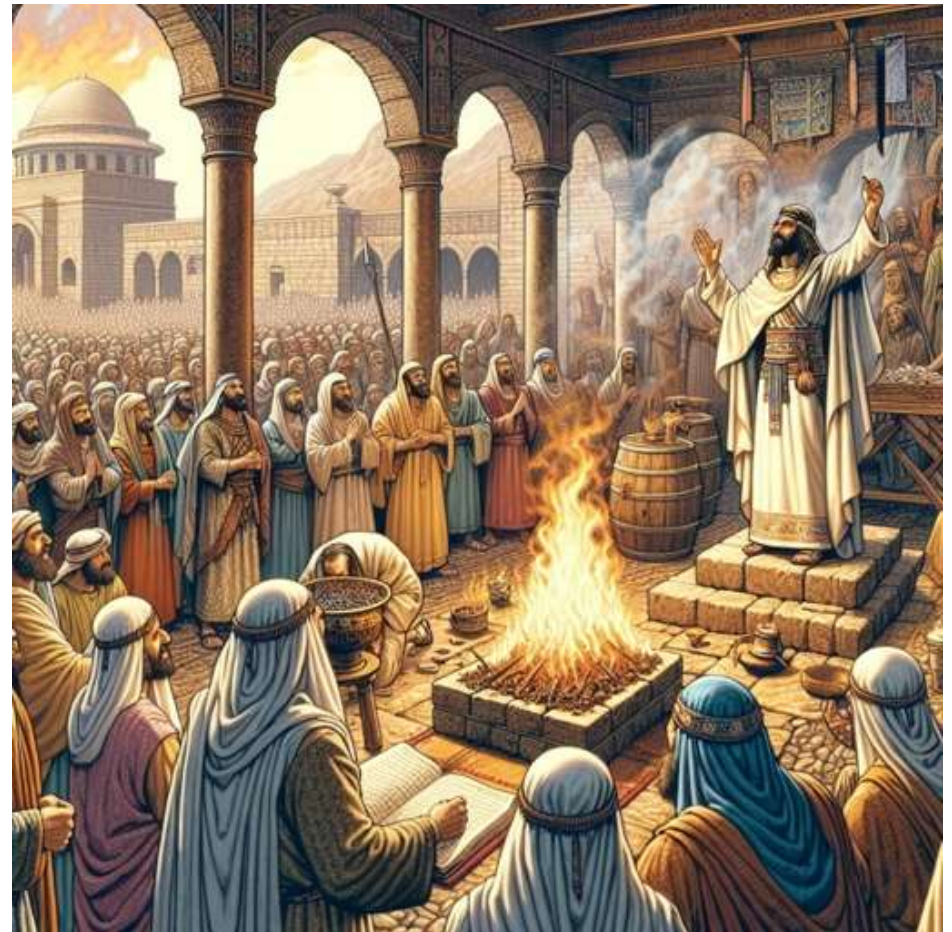
- And he said unto him that was over the vestry, Bring forth **vestments** for all the worshippers of Baal. And he brought them forth vestments. 2 Kings 10:22
- Does this remind you of the bells, smells, and clergy dress?
- Baal worshippers were big time on vestments.
 - And Jehu went, and Jehonadab the son of Rechab, into the house of Baal, and said unto the worshippers of Baal, **Search, and look that there be here with you none of the servants of the LORD, but the worshippers of Baal only.** 2 Kings 10:23
- Jehu and Jehonadab went into the house of Baal.
- And before they killed all these people, they searched out the house of Baal so that none of the servants of the Lord were killed.
- This is a picture of the cleansing of the church. (Ezekiel 9)
- **Right now, Jesus Christ, the righteous king, is searching and removing all the true worshippers before he brings judgement.**



- **If you have wondered why a relationship has been severed, possibly God is getting you away from those that will be judged.**
- There are all kinds of corruption, fornication, homosexuality, etc., going on between church leaders and staff.
- **God may take you out of situations to save your life before judgement falls.**
- There may be some people in your life that God does not want in your life.
- **Do not get close to a Baal worshipper.**
- **The house is full. It's like a big convention.** Look at the crowd.
 - And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. Revelation 18:4



- And when they went in to offer sacrifices and burnt offerings, Jehu appointed fourscore men without, and said, *If any of the men whom I have brought into your hands escape, he that letteth him go, his life shall be for the life of him.*
- And it came to pass, **as soon as he had made an end of offering** the burnt offering, that Jehu said to the guard and to the captains, **Go in, and slay them;** let none come forth. And they **smote them** with the edge of the sword; and the guard and the captains **cast them out**, and went to the **city of the house of Baal**. 2 Kings 10:24-25
- They went into the **city** of the house of Baal like a cleansing judgement.
- The “**city** of Baal” is a counterfeit city.



- And they brought forth the images out of the house of Baal, and **burned** them.
- And they **brake** down the image of Baal, and brake down the house of Baal, and made it a draught house unto this day.
- Thus Jehu destroyed Baal out of Israel. 2 Kings 10:26-28
- This is comparable to the revival in Ephesus when they brought out the curious arts and the magic books and burned them. (Acts 19:18-20)



- And to you who are troubled rest with us, **when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,**
- **In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:**
- Who shall be **punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord,** and from the glory of his power;
2 Thessalonians 1:7-9
- All that was in the house of Baal was **burned** with fire, the images were **broken** down, and it was made **an outhouse.**
- **This was the destiny of the house of Baal**
 - But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and **the works that are therein shall be burned up.** 2 Peter 3:10



- The end of Jehu's reign is sad (2 Kings 10:29-36).
- He did not depart from the golden calves.
- But the Lord said, "Because you did do what I said, I will bless you to the fourth generation."
 - Howbeit *from* the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, *to wit*, the golden calves that *were* in Bethel, and that *were* in Dan.
 - And the LORD said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing *that which is* right in mine eyes, *and* hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that *was* in mine heart, thy children of the fourth *generation* shall sit on the throne of Israel.
 - But **Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the LORD God of Israel with all his heart: for he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin. 2 Kings 10:29-31**



Elisha's Final Prophecy

- Now **Elisha was fallen sick** of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.
- And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.
- And he said to the king of Israel, Put thine hand upon the bow. And he put his hand *upon it*: and Elisha put his hands upon the king's hands.
- And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened *it*. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed *them*.
- And he said, Take the arrows. And he took *them*. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed.
- And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed *it*: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria *but* thrice.
 - This talks of unbelief and limiting God.
- And Elisha died, and they buried him. And **the bands of the Moabites** invaded the land at the coming in of the year.
- **And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet. 2 Kings 13:14-21**

- The dead Moabite was resurrected **when he touched the dead bones of Elijah**.
 - **That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection.**
Philippians 3:10
- This final story about the prophet Elisha illustrates the overwhelming presence of God, **showing the power and aura of Elisha's double portion anointing**.
- It also proves there is life after death.
- Elijah was honored in his departure and Elisha was honored after his departure.
- To touch the bones of Elisha was to come into intimate contact with them.
- The prophetic spirit of Elisha who came in the spirit of Elijah was again a type of our Lord Jesus.
- The **Elijah anointing was in the bones**, and it was passed down.
- The anointing in Elijah's bones could **raise the dead**, and if you ever **touch** it, you will never be the same.
 - But if the Spirit of him that **raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you**, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also **quicken your mortal bodies** by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Romans 8:11
- The baton has been passed to us. We must go forth with the **hopes, dreams** and **unfulfilled expectations** of those who have died in Christ.



- Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with **so great a cloud of witnesses**, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset *us*, and **let us run with patience the race that is set before us**. Hebrews 12:1
- **The elimination of Baal worship is coming.**
- **Where is your heart?**
- *The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. Revelation 11:15*



Behold, I will **send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.** Malachai 4:5
