Matthew 20:16; Isaiah 48:10

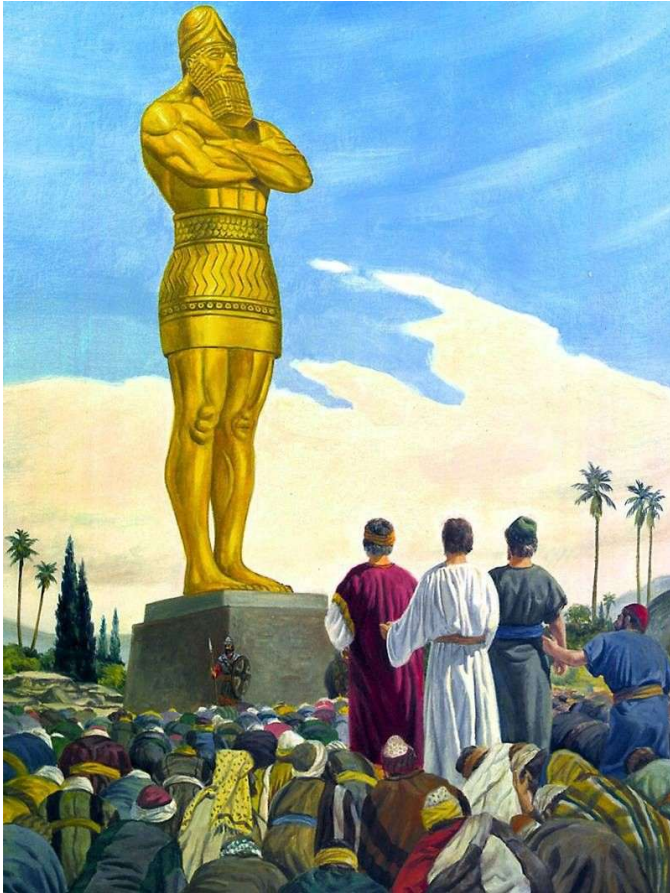
The third chapter of the book of Daniel is a classic passage.

Nebuchadnezzar the king made an **IMAGE of gold**, whose height was **THREESCORE** cubits, *and* the breadth thereof **SIX** cubits: he set it up... at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, ...and all kinds of **MUSIK**, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up: And whoso falleth not down and worshipping shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a **BURNING FIREY FURNANCE**.... There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, **SHADRACH, MESHACH**, and **ABEDNEGO**; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: ... *therefore* he spake, and commanded that they should heat the **FURNANCE one SEVEN TIMES** more than it was wont to be heated. And he commanded the most mighty men that *were* in his army to bind ...*and* to cast *them* into the burning fiery furnace... Then Nebuchadnezzar ... said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men **BOUND** into the midst of the fire? ... Lo, I see **FOUR** men **LOOSE, WALKING** in the midst of the fire, and they have **NO** hurt; and the **FORM** of the fourth is like the **SON OF GOD**. Daniel 3:1-25



- Do you remember the words of Him that **FORMED** Israel?
 - When thou **walkest through the FIRE**, **thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.**
Isaiah 43:2
- This literally happened to the three Hebrew children.
 - And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose **BODIES** the **FIRE** had **NO POWER**, nor was an **HAIR** of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the **SMELL** of **FIRE** had passed on them...Then the king **PROMOTED** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon...Who through faith ...Quenched the violence of fire.
Daniel 3:27,30; Hebrews 11:33-34



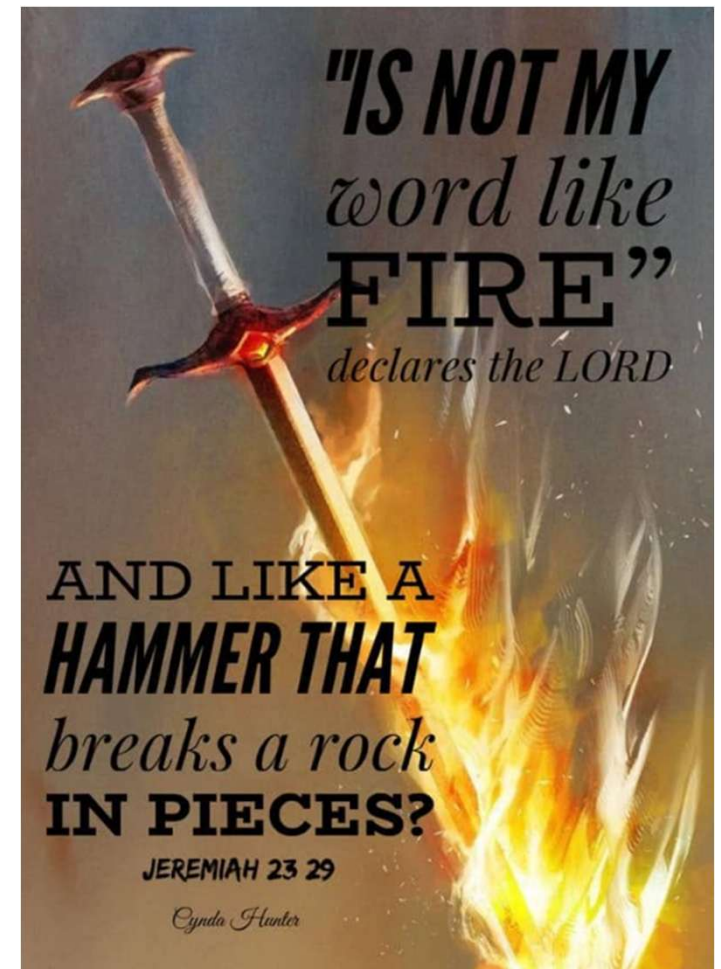


- The golden image was marked by the principle of **MAN**.
- It was **SIXTY cubits high** and its breadth was **SIX cubits**.
- **Six is the number of MAN.**
- There are those today who **refuse to bow** to the **image of MAN** when the **music** plays.
- There are those who **refuse** to give first place to the **carnal mind** and the **spirit of antichrist**.
- It is significant that this **man-worship** was prompted by **MUSIC**.
- Much of the so-called “**Christian**” music is not Scriptural and **does not glorify and honor the Lord Jesus**.

- They honor what Nebuchadnezzar built, the **god of SELF** and the **carnal mind**.
- Thank God that **three did not bow**.
- Thank God for men today **who will not bow**.
- Their blessed lot is a **burning fiery furnace**.
- If you find yourself in the **fire, rejoice!**
- It is proof of our sonship turning from idolatry.
 - Blessed *are* they which are **persecuted for righteousness' sake**: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
 - Blessed are ye, **when *men* shall revile you, and persecute you**, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
 - Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great *is* your reward in heaven: **for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.** Matthew 5:10-12



- The **furnace** was heated **SEVEN** times hotter than usual.
- Seven is God's number and reveals the truth that **God's own nature will be produced in the fire.**
- Then again, **God IS the furnace.**
 - And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, **behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp** that passed between those pieces. Genesis 15:17
- And **God IS the consuming fire.**
 - For our **God is a consuming fire.** Hebrews 12:29
- Specifically, **God is the WORD, and the WORD is a FIRE.**
 - **In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.** John 1:1
 - **Is not my word like as a fire?** saith the LORD; and **like a hammer that breaketh the rock** in pieces? Jeremiah 23:29



- The attitude of the three Hebrews would cross some contemporary thinking in regard to deliverance.
- They were **ready to believe God to bring them through** the fire.
- Listen to their confession and compare it with startling, balancing statement of truth from the writer to the Hebrews.
 - Nebuchadnezzar, we *are* not careful to answer thee in this matter. If it be so, **our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand**, O king. **BUT IF NOT**, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up...and others were tortured, **NOT ACCEPTING DELIVERANCE**; that they might obtain a better resurrection Daniel 3:16-18; Hebrews 11:35

- There are many benefits to the **furnace** experience.
- Let me condense them into **four thoughts**:
 - **The mighty men of Babylon perish** when they **cast** you into the **furnace**.
 - **You are loosed** in the **furnace**
 - **You will astonish Babylon** by **walking** in the **furnace**.
 - **You will meet Jesus in the furnace.**
- “**Babylon**” means “**confusion**” and comes from a root word meaning “to **MIX**”.
- It is means “**the gate of God**”.
- Babylon speaks of **religious confusion** and a **MIXTURE** of truth and tradition.
- This is **DESTROYED** by the furnace experience.



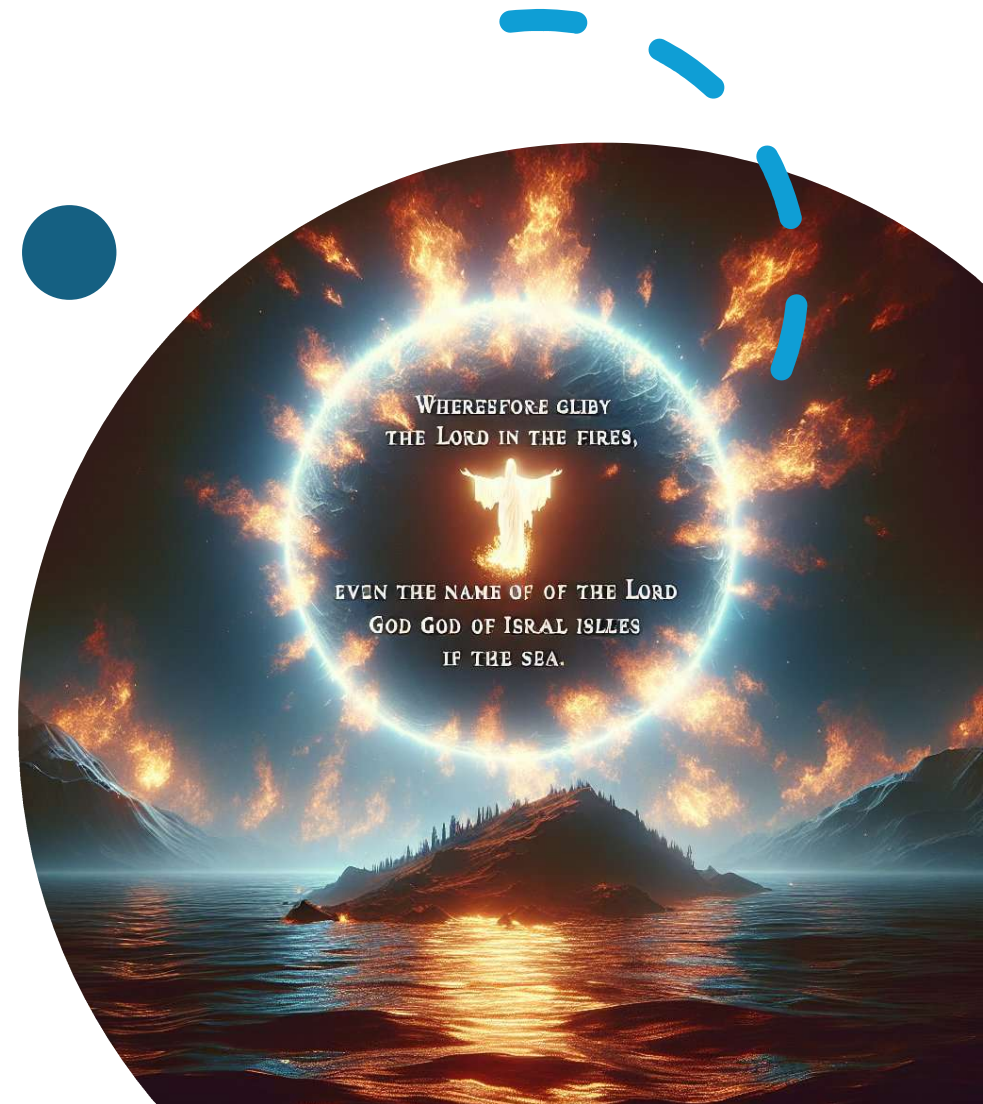
- The **mighty men** of Babylon, whether **demons**, or **giants of fear and unbelief**, **are consumed by the flames**.
- When we **refuse to walk with the crowd**, our strongest shackles and bondages and confusions and frustrations **will be destroyed** in the **fiery Presence of God**.
- We go into the **furnace bound**.
- We come out of the furnace **LOOSED** and are given a promotion in the government.
- There is a **glorious liberty** in the **fire**.
- The three Hebrew children “**fell down bound**” into the **flames**.
- It must have been **hard to get up**.
- Perhaps they just laid there and let the ropes burn off. **HALLELUJAH!**



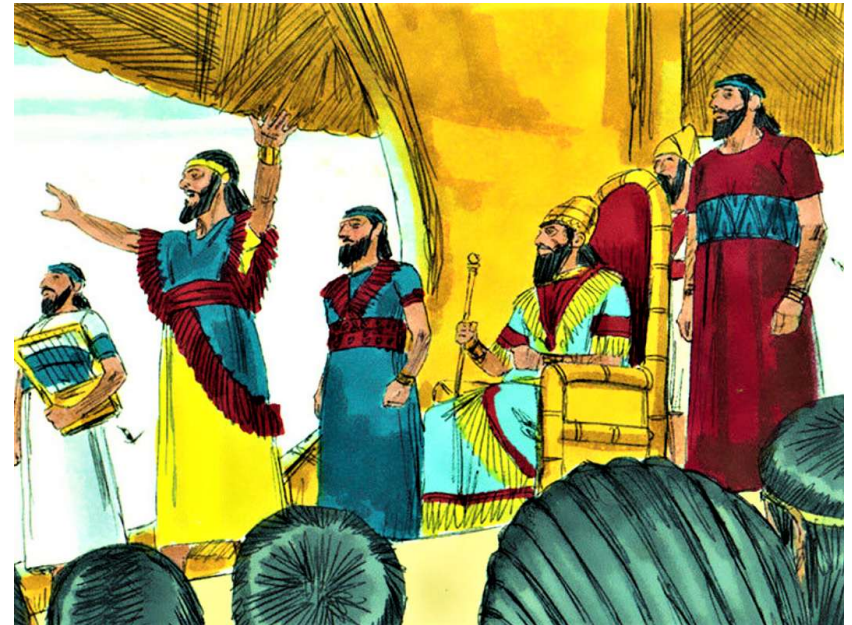
- The god and prince of this **world system** will be **shocked** at our deliverance.
- The **rulers of the religious systems** will be **astonished** when they see a **people who cannot be moved**.
- The Lord Jesus **confounded** and **shocked** the Pharisees of His day.
- There is an **overcoming army** on the horizon **just like Him!**
- There were **four men in the furnace**.
- Whether you believe that the fourth man was Daniel, or whether you believe that this was a Christophany (an appearance of Christ), the principle remains, **you will meet JESUS in the FURNACE!**
- “The **FORM** of the **fourth** is **LIKE** the **Son of God**”.
- The **formation of His likeness** becomes a **reality in the fire**.



- And note that they were **WALKING in the MIDST of the flames.**
- They were not huddled over in the corner **complaining** about the room **temperature.**
- Most would say, “O God, hurry up and **turn this heat down!**”.
- They were **glorifying the Lord in the fires.**
 - Wherefore glorify ye the LORD in the fires. Isaiah 24:15
- There is an enabling of the Holy Ghost **from within** that will let you **SING in the fire!**
- Can we **walk comfortably in the furnace,** or will we **respond** with anger and bitterness?
- I pray that we will **learn the purpose of the furnace.**



- We have experienced a baptism in **water** and in the **Holy Ghost** preparatory to baptism in **FIRE** that reveals the **nature** of every man and brings man **into the experience of his LORDSHIP**.
- If we **suffer** with Him, we shall **reign** with Him.
- Only those who experience the **furnace** will be promoted in the **government** of God.
- Let us present our bodies as a **living sacrifice** as we follow on in His purposes.
 - *Then* Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, **Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego**, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and **have changed the king's word**, and yielded their bodies, **that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God**. Daniel 3:28



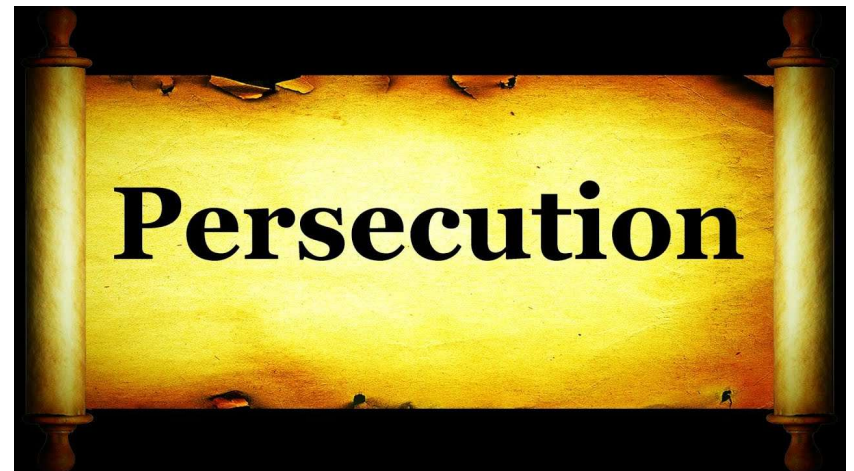
- The Lord Jesus must be the **Pattern** for every principle that we teach.
- How did He handle trouble?
- Did He **avoid** it or **overcome** it?
- Actually, the question is redundant, for He **condescended** into the realm of death to that end.
- But let's look at what happened in His ministry in Nazareth.
 - And all they in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath, And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong. But he **PASSING THROUGH the midst of them** went his way. Luke 4:28-30
- The same one that **passed through** that angry **crowd**, also **passed through the heavens**.
 - Seeing then that we have a great high priest, **that is passed into the heavens**, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* profession. Hebrews 4:14



- He is the **Overcoming, Risen Lord!**
- Don't be surprised when men of the flesh rise up and **hate the truth.**
- This religious mob wanted to throw Him over that forty-foot brow of the hill.
- **HE is the example for us.**
- He **pressed THROUGH.**
- Another instance of this is given in John's Gospel.
 - Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw *it*, and was glad. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. Then took they up stones to cast at him: **but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, GOING THROUGH the midst of them, and so passed by.** John 8:56-59



- We are not going out, **we are going THROUGH!**
- When Jesus faced **danger** and **death**, He **overcame** it by **going through it**.
- Note that in both examples it was the **WORD** that brought the **trouble**.
- The **truth of this Gospel** will bring us into the place of **tribulation**.
- Jesus said:
 - But he that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that heareth the WORD, and anon with joy receiveth it; Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: **for when TRIBULATION or PERSECUTION ariseth BECAUSE OF THE WORD**, by and by he is offended. Matthew 13:20-21
- Don't drop out.
- Don't die on the operating table.
- Jonah found a ship because he was looking for one.
- The Word of the Lord has brought us out of Egypt.
- The Word of the Lord is bringing us through the wilderness.
- The Word of the Lord will bring us into the land.



- And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and to Iconium, and Antioch, Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, **and that we must MUCH TRIBULATION enter into the kingdom of God.** Acts 14:21-22

- We **MUST** through much tribulation enter into the Kingdom of God.
- The word for “**MUST**” means “**IT IS NECESSARY**”.
- It comes from the root word, “TO BIND.”
- We are **bound** to this principle.
- **Tribulation is necessary** if we are to enter the Kingdom of God.



- I am **exhorting** and **encouraging** you to **continue in the faith**.
- You **MUST** experience tribulation.
- It is **necessary**.
- This word is also used in the following Scriptures:
 - And he began to teach them, that **the Son of man MUST suffer many things**, and **be rejected** of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and **be killed**, and after three days rise again. Mark 8:31
 - Wist ye not that I **MUST** be about my Father's business? Luke 2:49
 - And he said unto them, I **MUST** preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent. Luke 4:43
 - God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him **MUST** worship *him* in spirit and in truth. John 4:24
- No student of the Bible in his right spiritual mind would argue any of the examples given above.
- **In every case, "IT IS NECESSARY".**
- And we **MUST** enter the Kingdom through tribulation.



- What is the Kingdom of God?
 - For the **kingdom of God** is not meat and drink; but **righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost**. Romans 14:17
- The Kingdom of God is not some dry old doctrine.
- The Kingdom of God is a **present reality**.
- It is a **LIFESTYLE** filled with **RIGHTEOUSNESS** and **PEACE** and **JOY**.
- It is a walk in the **HOLY GHOST**.
- Get **filled** with the King.
- Get enough of Him so that your family and your neighbors can see Him!
- **We will pay a price for a walk like this.**

the **Kingdom** of **God**
is **Righteousness**
Peace and **Joy**
in the **Holy Spirit**
Romans 14:17

- The prophet Daniel said that there would be two kinds of Christians in the end of this age:
 - Those who would be **worn out** by the beast systems.
 - And he shall speak *great* words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High. Daniel 7:25
 - Those who would be **strong** and **do exploits**, because **they know their God**.
 - **but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.** Daniel 11:32
- The word for “**WEAR OUT**” means “to afflict or wear out in a **mental sense**, to afflict, to vex, to persecute with the purpose of entire annihilation.”
- Going back to the passage in Acts 14, we can see that this is what the Jews tried to do with Paul in verse 19 when they stoned him and dragged him out of the city.
- He later went back to Lystra, **bearing in his body the marks of the Lord**.
- He preached and demonstrated that we must **PRESS THROUGH tribulation**.
- Paul was an **overcomer**.
- He was **NOT worn out** because he **KNEW HIS GOD!**



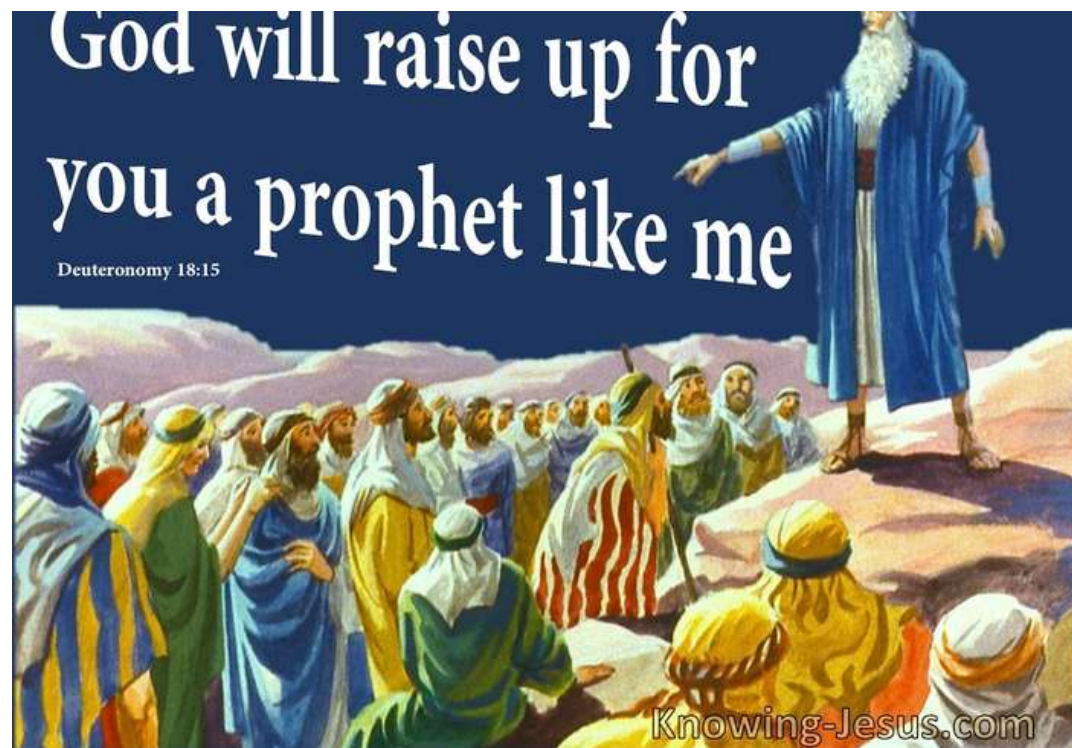
- Where do you get to **know God** and **His strength**?
- In the **valley of humiliation** and **degradation** and **heartache** and **pain**.
- In the **wilderness**; the place of **humiliation** and **brokenness**.
- In some of those **dark, lonely hours** when the evil one shoots his **fiery darts**.
- **It's not easy**.
- David gave us all some good advice:
 - But **I will surely buy *it* of thee at a price: neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing.** 2 Samuel 24:24



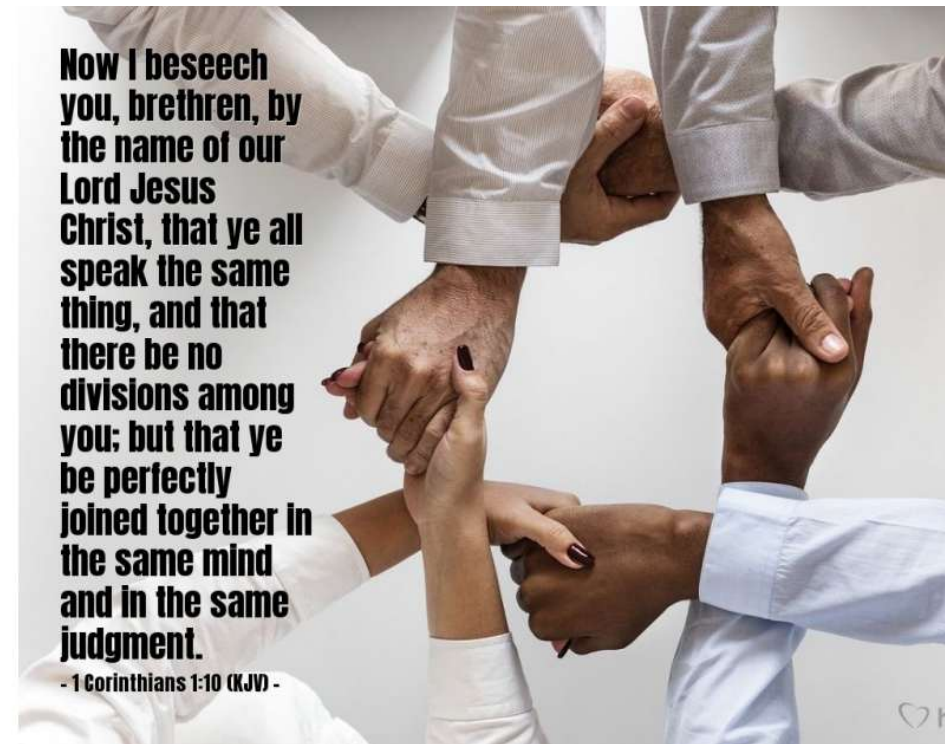
- This is a great day!
 - **This is the Day which the Lord hath made**; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Psalms 118:24
- If we will **dedicate** ourselves to God, He will do **exceeding abundantly** above all we can ask or think.
- You will do more than just muddle through, brothers and sisters.
- You will **stand** in the battle **in the Day of the Lord**.
 - Ye have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel **to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD**. Ezekiel 13:5
- You will **stand in the evil day** and have **boldness** in the **day of judgement**.
 - Wherefore take unto you the **whole armour of God**, that ye may be able to **withstand in the evil day**, and having done all, **to stand**. Ephesians 6:13



- **Out** of Egypt, **THROUGH** the wilderness, **into** the land.
- God brought **Israel out of Egypt** by the hand of Moses.
- **Moses** was a **SHEPHERD**.
- After Moses died, the governmental responsibilities were turned over to Joshua.
- **Joshua** was a **SOLDIER**.
- Both **Moses** and **Joshua** are **types** of our Lord and Savior, **JESUS CHRIST**.
- Moses himself declared that a **Prophet** would be raised up like unto him and that **Prophet was Jesus**.
 - **I will raise them up a Prophet** from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. Deuteronomy 18:18
 - For Moses truly said unto the fathers, **A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me;** him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, *that* every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people. Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days. Acts 3:22-23



- The names **JOSHUA** and **JESUS** mean the same thing: **Jehovah the Savior.**"
- **Joshua** is a type of **Jesus** as the **Captain** of our salvation.
 - For it became him, for whom *are* all things, and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, **to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.**
Hebrews 2:10
- Jesus is the **General** and the **HEAD** of this army!
- Keep **praying** for your city and **give yourself** to the **Lord Jesus** and His **Word**.
- Be **teachable**.
- Be of **one mind** and **one judgement**.
 - Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, **that ye all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you; but *that* ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.** 1 Corinthians 1:10



- **Learn** these principles of the Kingdom and **grow up** in Christ.
- **You will pay a price.**
- You are on the **threshold** of the land.
- We have been brought to the **edges** of His ways.
- The land is before us, and a new age **beckons**.
- Our **Heavenly Joshua** is leading us on.
 - And it came to pass after three days, that the officers went through the host; And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the ARK of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about TWO THOUSAND cubits by measure: come not near unto it, that ye may know the way by which ye must go: for ye have not passed *this* way heretofore. And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for to morrow the LORD will do wonders among you...And as they that bare the ARK were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ARK were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) That the waters which came down from above stood *and* rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam...Joshua 3:2-5, 15-16



And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for to morrow the Lord will do wonders among you.

JOSHUA 3:5 KJV

- The **Ark of the Covenant** speaks to us of **Jesus Christ** in His **KINGSHIP** and **LORDSHIP**.
- Note that it is called the **Ark of the Covenant** “of the Lord of all the earth” in Joshua 3:11.
- In a time when circumstances say NO, God is saying to His Church:
 - **Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.**
Joshua 1:3
- It is time to **possess** the land.
- Be **strong** and of **good courage**.
- The king of Jericho shudders at the thought of the **Overcomer** who is **WITHIN YOU**.



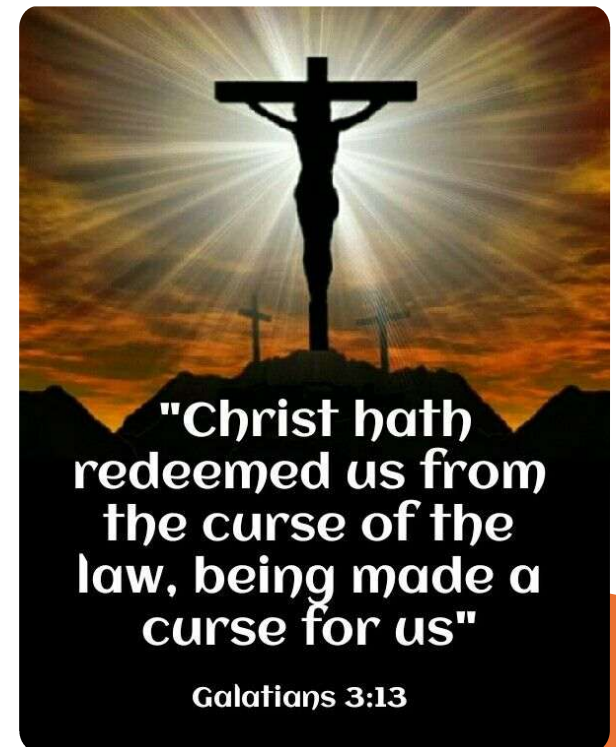
- **Arise and leave your place of fear and unbelief for:**

- “It is time to take the Kingdom,
 - Rise up, ye strong, ‘tis Christ’s command,
 - For every power and dominion
 - Is given now into your hand!
-
- Ye that have ears to hear the trumpet,
 - Ye that have hearts to understand,
 - It is the time to take the Kingdom,
 - Rise up, ye strong, and possess the land!”

- There is a **priestly ministry** that is upholding His **Lordship**.
- We are **walking** toward the **impossible**.
- But do not fear, for **Jesus the Ark** has **conquered death** and has opened up the **glorious mystery** that has been **hidden** for generations.
- Jordan has been **divided** asunder.
- The veil has been **rent**, and all that was **concealed** is now made **open** to you.
- **The table is spread.**
- Come boldly, for 2000 cubits behind **the Ark was a nation** that God **brought out so that He might bring them in**.
 - And **he brought us out from thence, that he might bring us in, to give us the land which he swore unto our fathers**. Deuteronomy 6:23



- Two thousand years ago, **Jesus conquered death, hell, and the grave**, and **opened** the land of our inheritance.
- Jordan was rolled back to ADAM.
- The Lord Jesus Christ, in His **death** and **resurrection**, cut off every hindrance clear back to ADAM!
- He took the **keys** and **ascended** up on high, leading **captivity captive**.
- He arose **victorious, King of kings, and Lord of lords!**
- He has **rolled back** every limitation: sin, sickness, poverty, and death.
 - **Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us:** for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree. Galatians 3:13



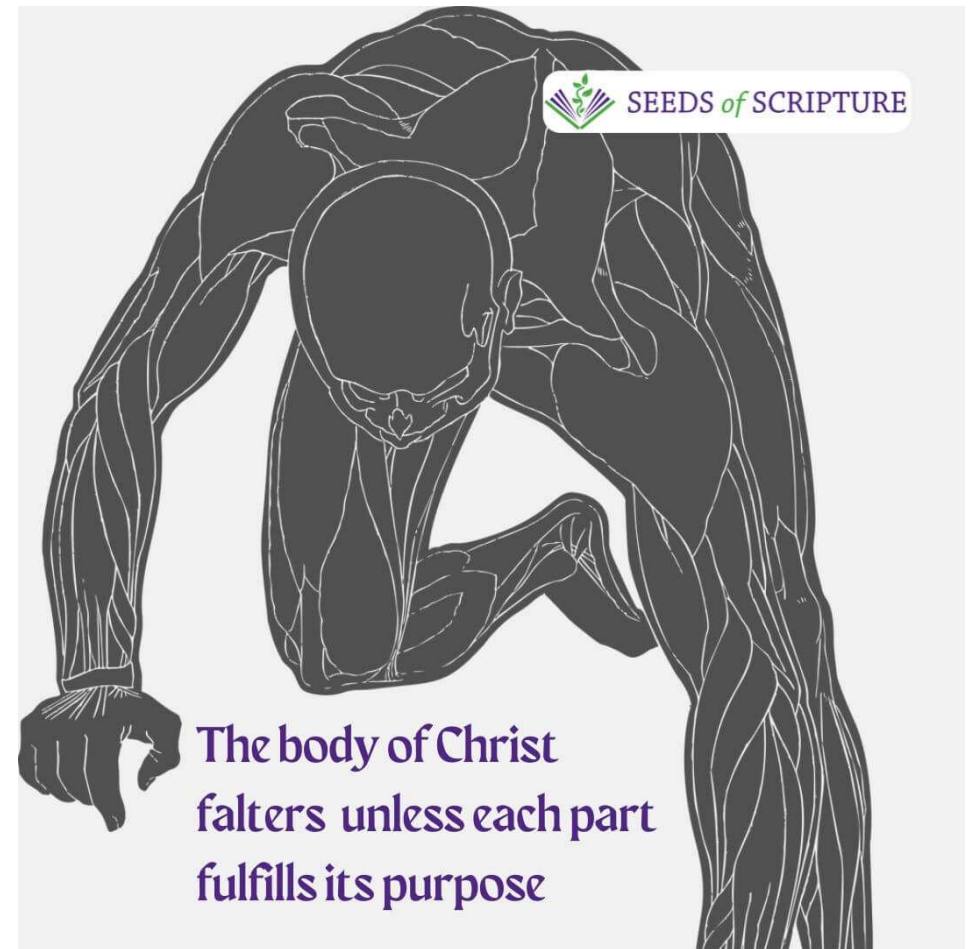
- And 2000 years (cubits) later there is a **HOLY NATION**, His **Glorious Church**, that is going to **follow the Ark** into the land and **walk in everything that He died for!**
- We are going to **put our foot on all enemies.**
- We are going to **reign on the earth.**
 - Ask of me, and I **shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance**, and the uttermost parts of the earth *for* thy possession. Psalms 2:8
 - And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and **we shall reign on the earth.** Revelation 5:10
- We have a job to do!



- You will never **conquer** Canaan until God has brought you **through the wilderness**.
- Until you learn to **press through tribulation**, you will not **qualify** for God's **army**.
- I am a part of this move of God, and I want you to be a part of it, too.
- **As I finish this series, there is a sadness in my heart.**
- **Some of you are going to miss out on this visitation** because of those stinking, hellish **traditions** that you **have learned from men**.
- Those lies killed our loved ones and everybody else that learned them, and **they will us if we don't abandon them in the Name of the Lord**.
 - For to be **carnally minded *is* death**; but to be **spiritually minded *is* life and peace**.
Romans 8:6
 - **Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition**, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
Mark 7:13



- I am not speaking concerning doctrines as much as I am concerning **the way that people think...the way that we have thought all our lives...the lies that have been passed down from generation to generation.**
- And the granddaddy of all lies is this: “You cannot **have** anything; you cannot **be** anything, and you cannot **do** anything.”
- That stinking lie that says, “You cannot have these things. They are for someone else.”
- **His Body is disjointed.**
- His army lies **fragmented, hurting and bruised,, and wounded.**



The Hour of Doom

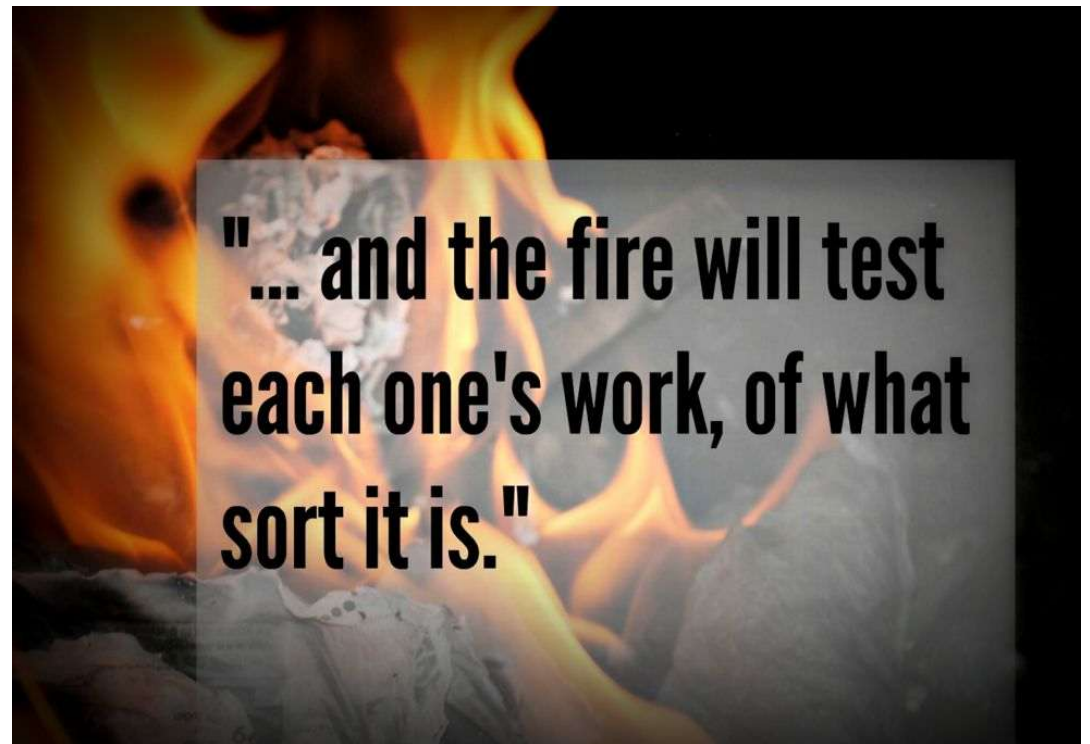
- Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Also, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD unto the land of Israel; **An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land.**
- **Now is the end come upon thee**, and I will send **mine anger upon thee**, and will **judge thee** according to thy ways, and will **recompense upon thee all thine abominations.**
- And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- Thus saith the Lord GOD; **An evil, an only evil, behold, is come.**
- **An end is come, the end is come:** it watcheth for thee; behold, it is come.
- The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, **the day of trouble is near**, and not the sounding again of the mountains.
- **Now will I shortly pour out my fury upon thee**, and accomplish mine anger upon thee: and I will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense thee for all thine abominations.
- And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: **I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations that are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I am the LORD that smiteth.**
- Behold the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; **the rod hath blossomed, pride hath budded.**
- **Violence is risen up into a rod of wickedness:** none of them *shall remain*, nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither *shall there be* wailing for them.
- The time is come, the day draweth near: **let not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn: for wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.**
- **For the seller shall not return to that which is sold**, although they were yet alive: for the vision *is* touching the whole multitude thereof, *which* shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the iniquity of his life.
- They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: **for my wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.** Ezekiel 7:14

- But something is happening in the true church!
- **The walls are coming down.**
- The **cry and travail of broken humanity** and the nagging, haunting travail of a groaning creation is causing us to forget our petty differences.
- The army that is standing is an **army of overcomers.**
- **Jesus is their Lord.**
- He has developed them, and **they have pressed through their adversities.**
- And on the other side of the wilderness, each of them shall say, “**The Spirit of the Lord is upon me!**”

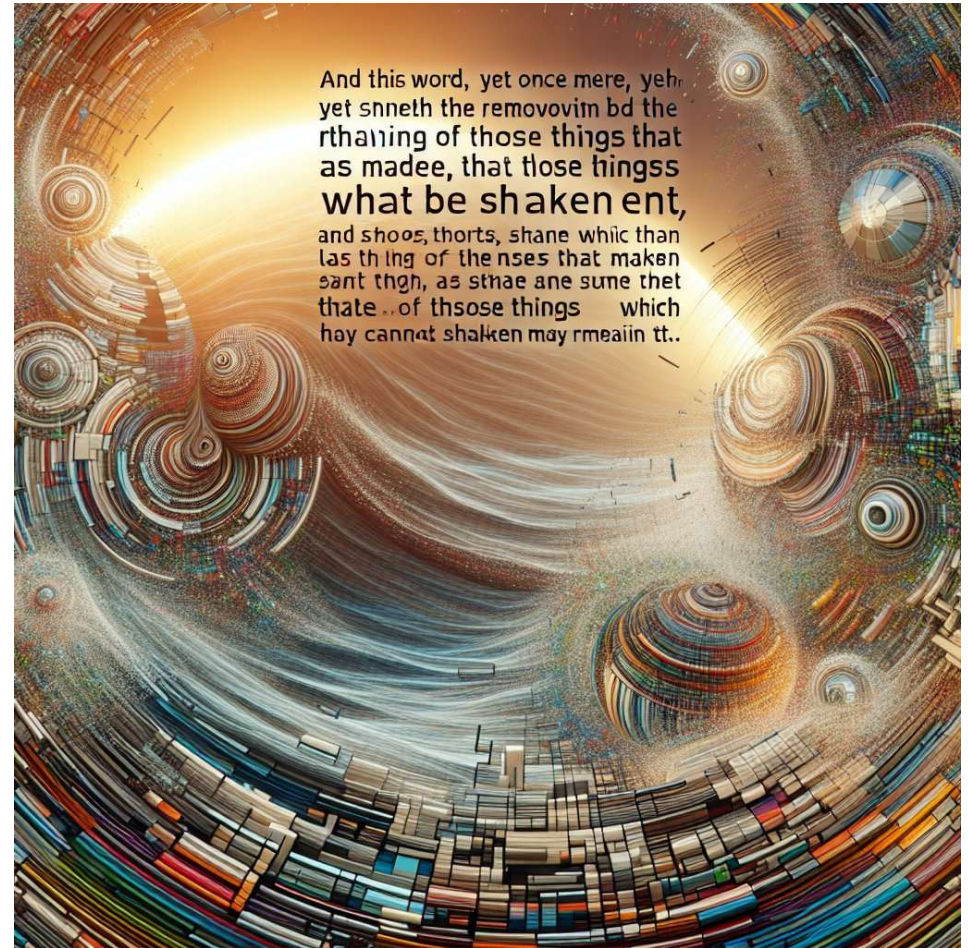


JESUS IS LORD

- Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;
- Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the Day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by FIRE; and the FIRE shall try every man's work of what sort (NATURE) it is.
- If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.
- If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by FIRE. 1
Corinthians 3:12-15



- This is the **Day of the Lord**.
- The **FIRE** of His **Word** is burning in this **Day**.
- He is **trying everything by that fire** and **shaking everything** that can be shaken.
- **Only His Kingdom will remain.**
 - Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, **Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.**
 - And this *word*, Yet once more, signifieth the **removing of those things that are shaken**, as of things that are made, **that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.**
 - Wherefore **we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved**, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:
 - **For our God is a consuming fire.** Hebrews 12:26-29
- **Only that which can stand the test of His Word will survive.**



- The same hot fire will **HARDEN the clay**, but it will **MELT the gold** so that it will flow.
- The **fire** is the **WORD**.
- The **clay** is the **OLD NATURE**.
- The **gold** is the **NEW NATURE**.
- Are you hardening, or are you **melting** and **flowing** in worship?
- The **Word** of the Lord in the **Day of the Lord** is revealing the **NATURE** of each one of us.
- **The purpose of the fire is to reveal what we are.**
